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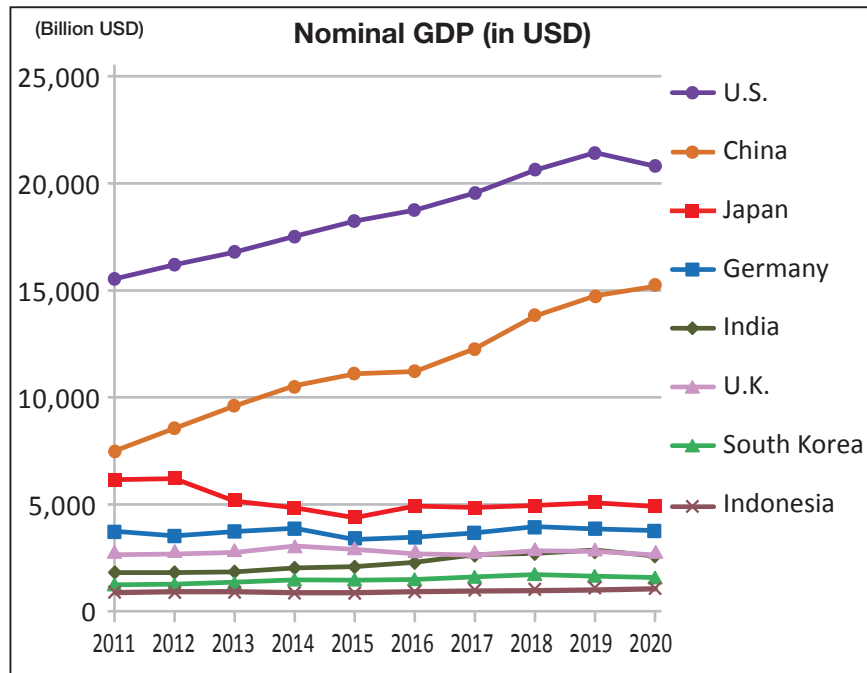
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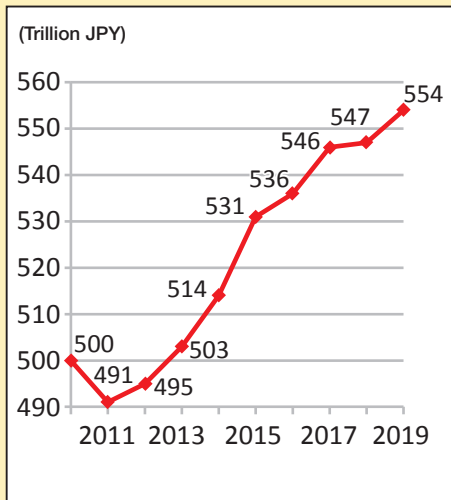

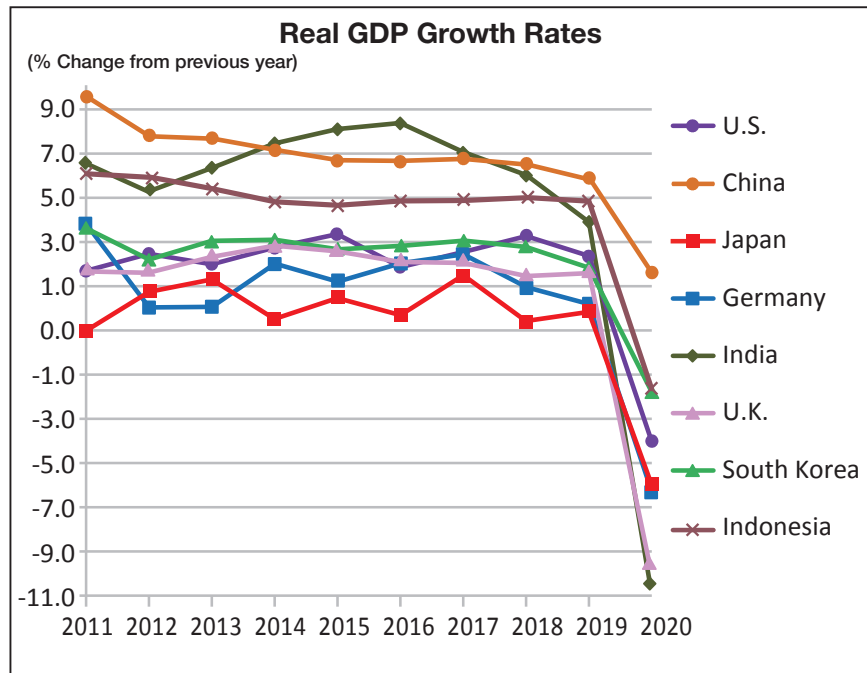

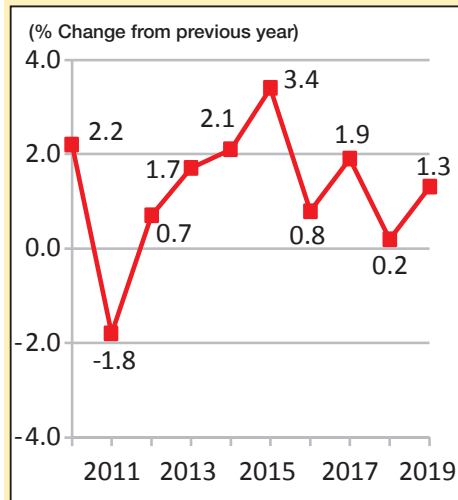

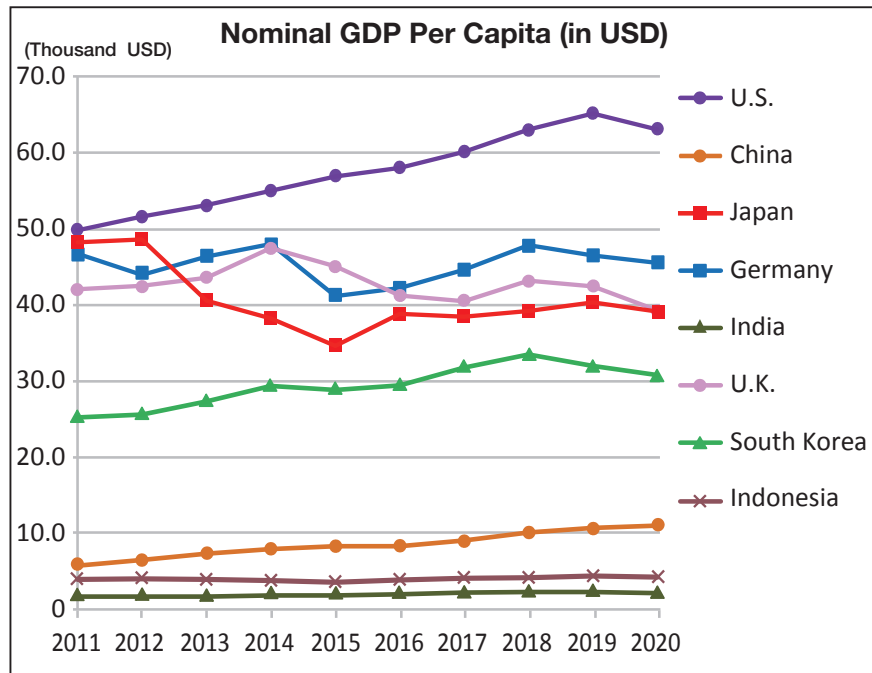

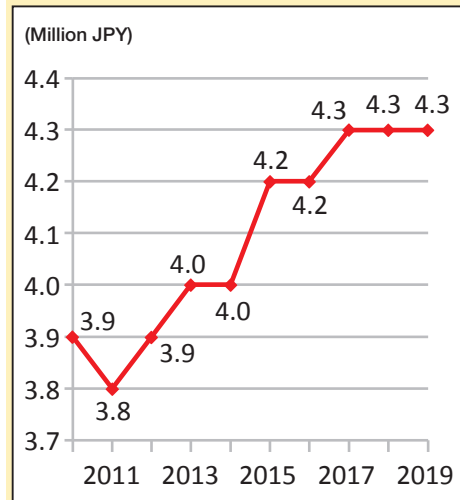

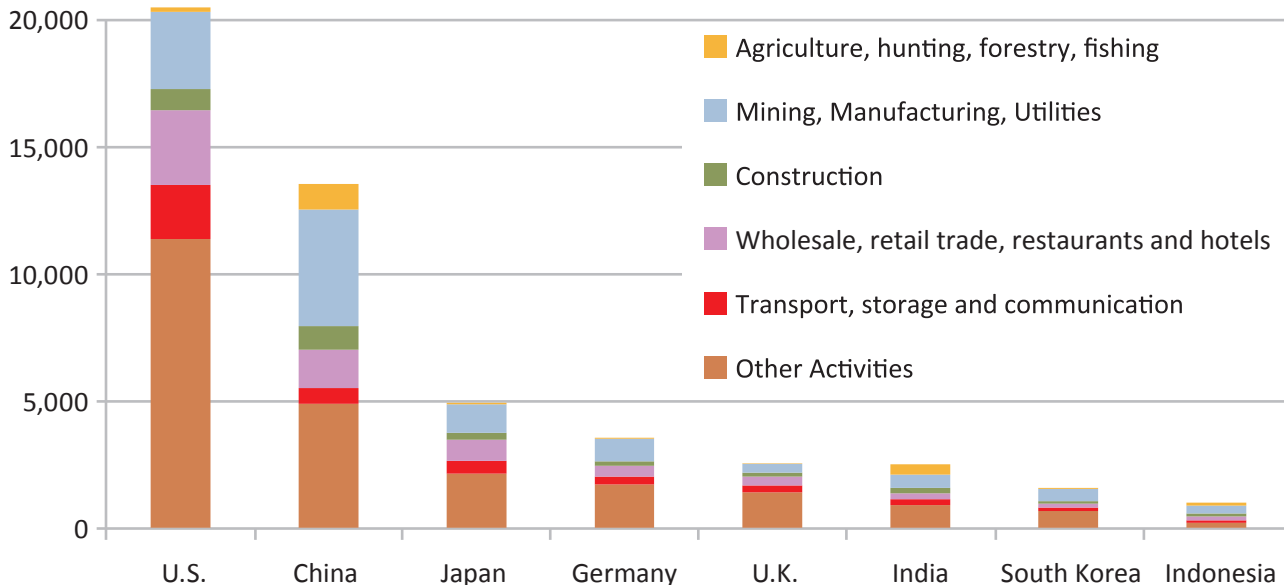

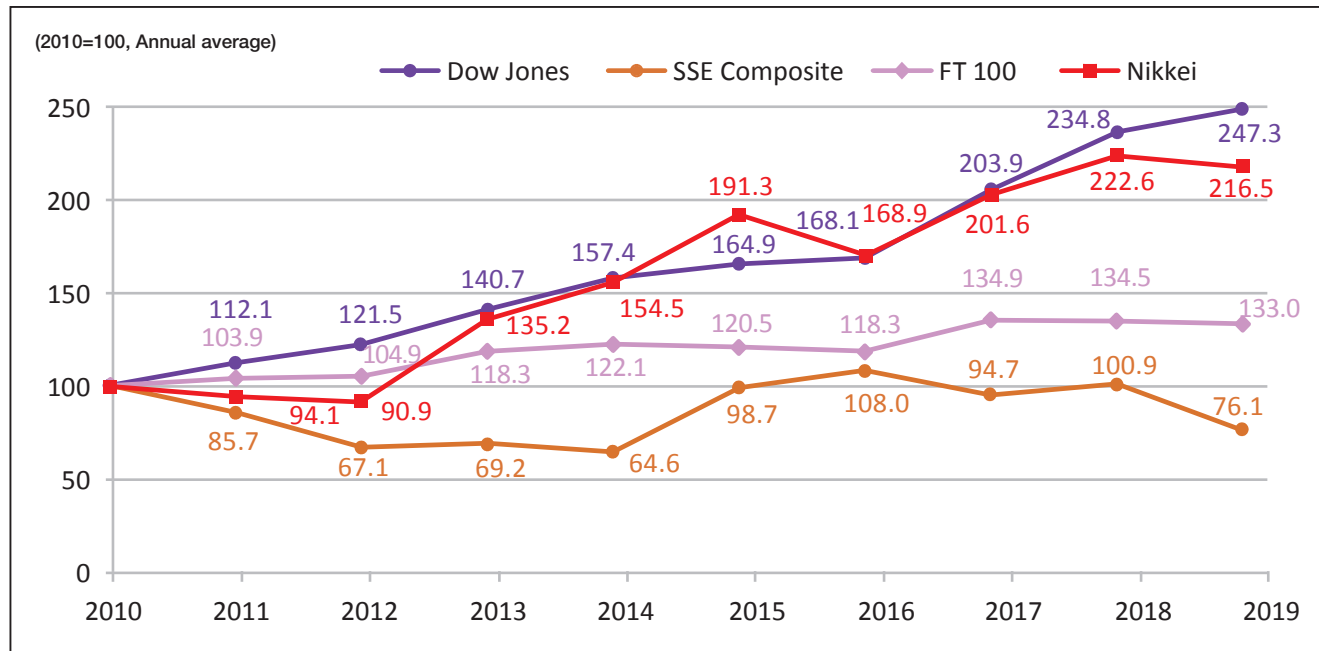

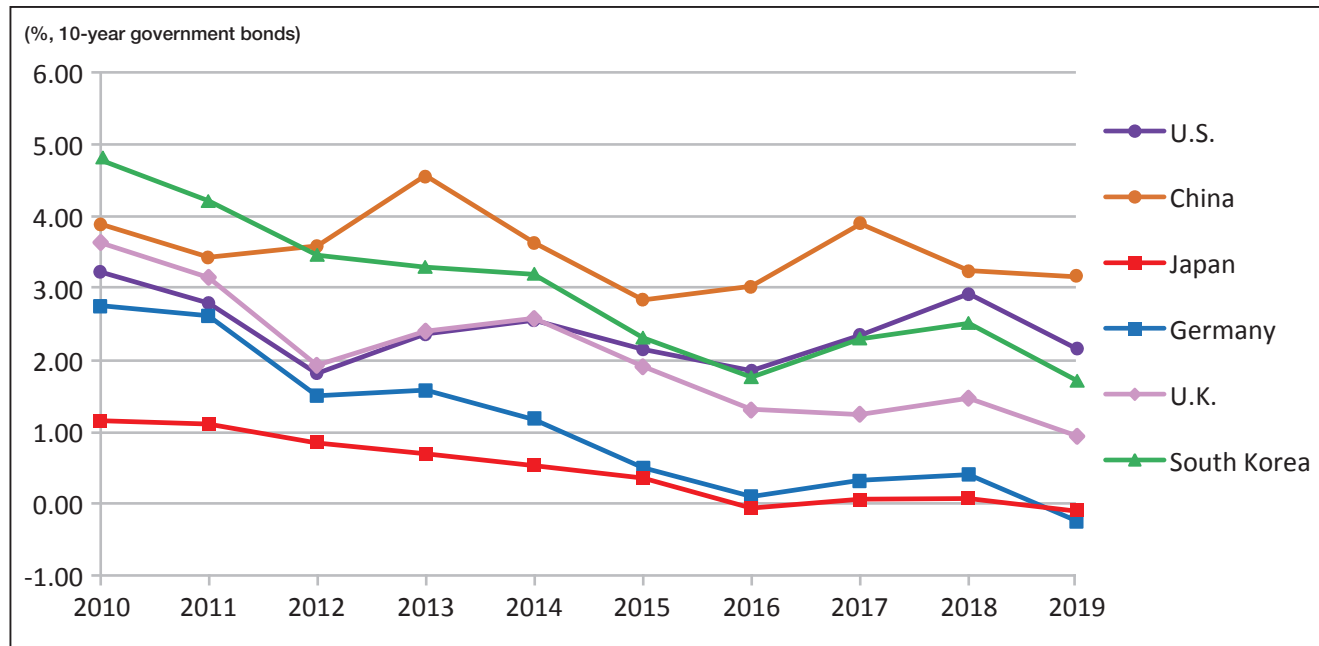

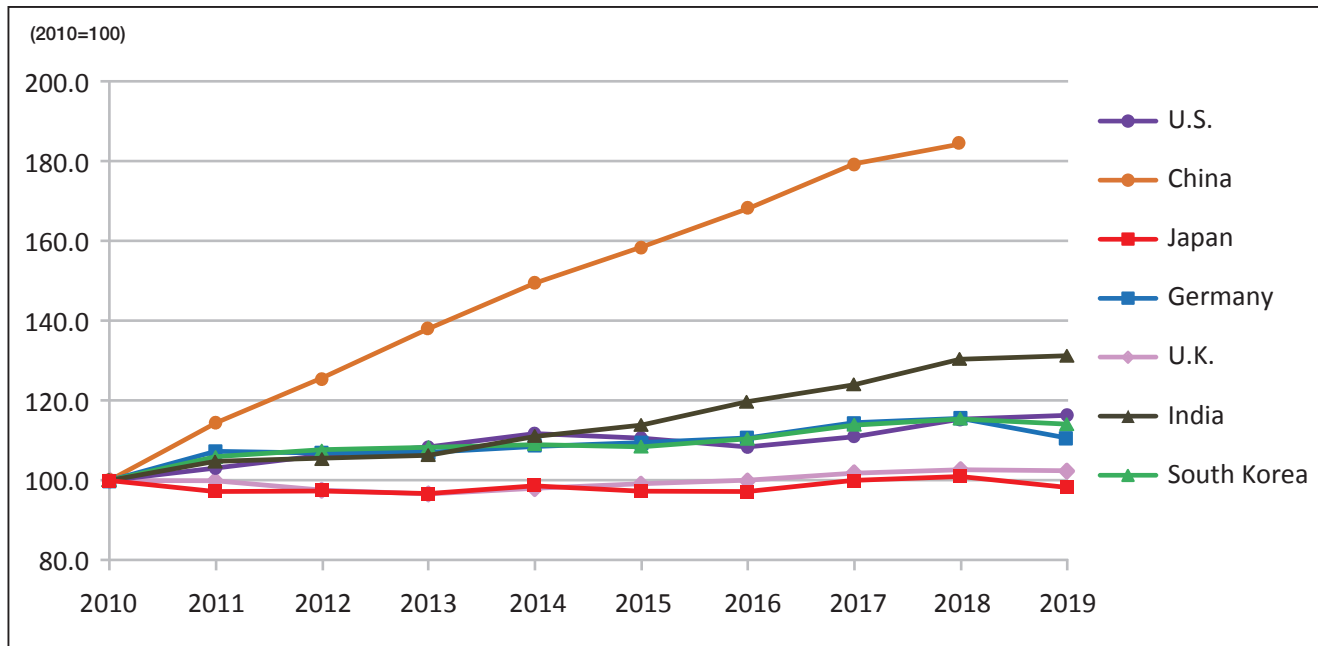

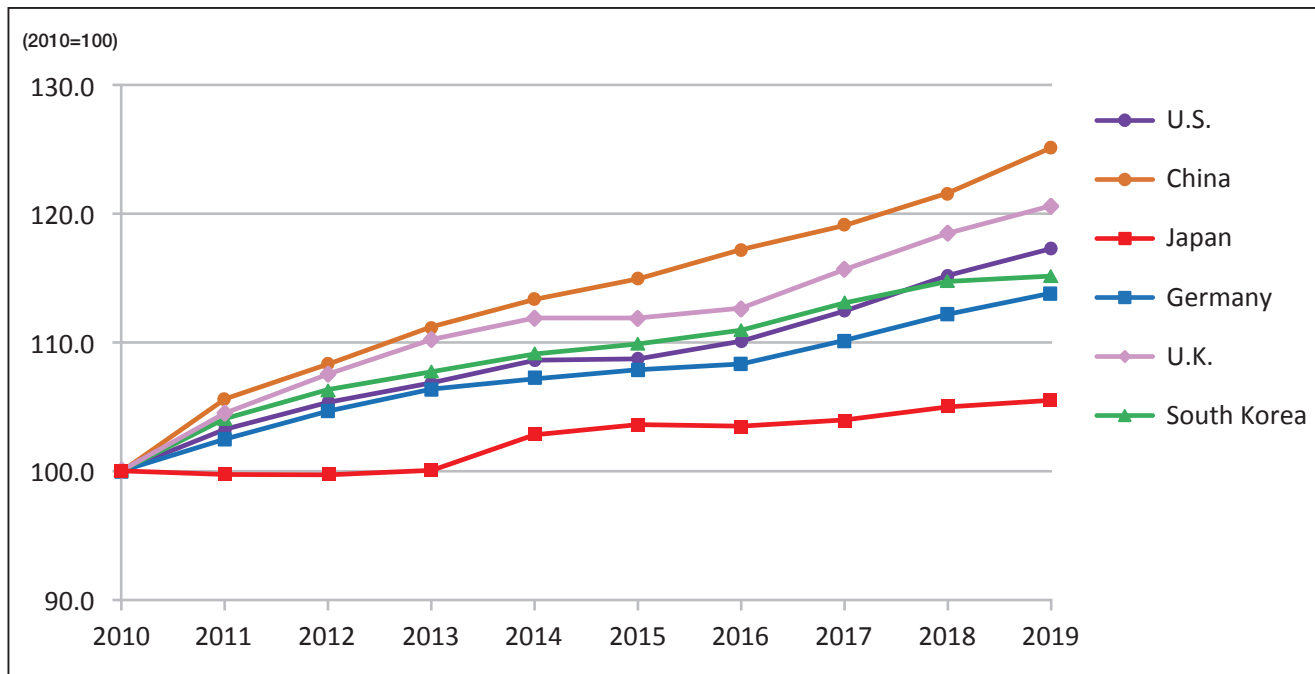

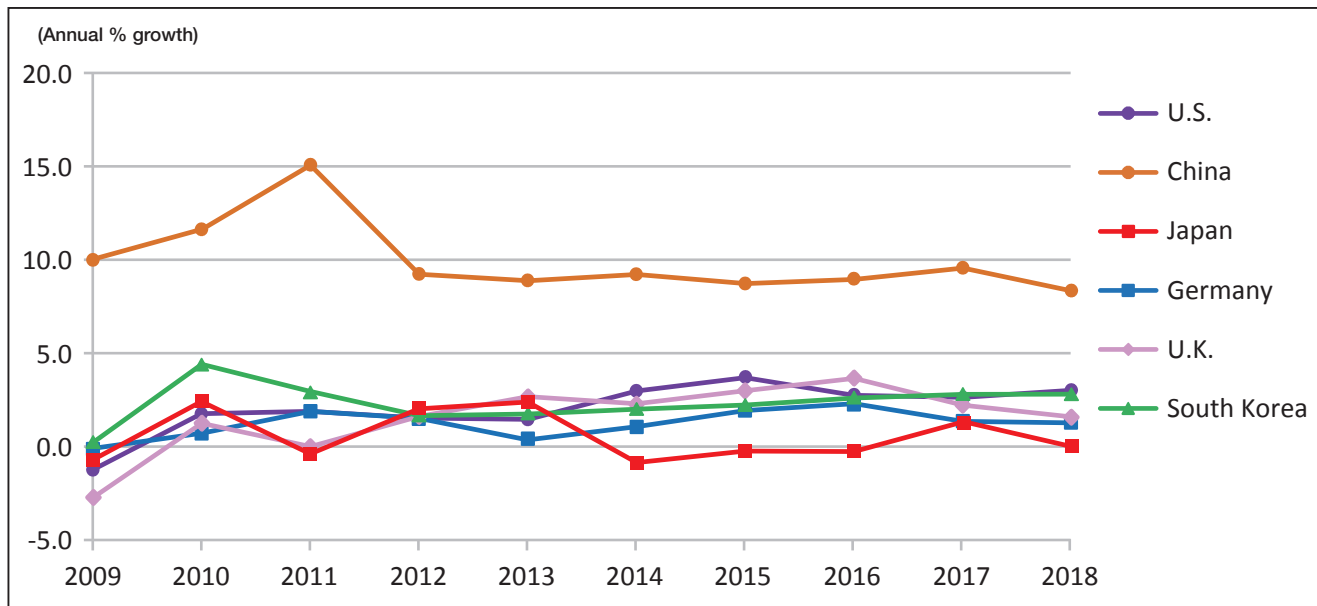

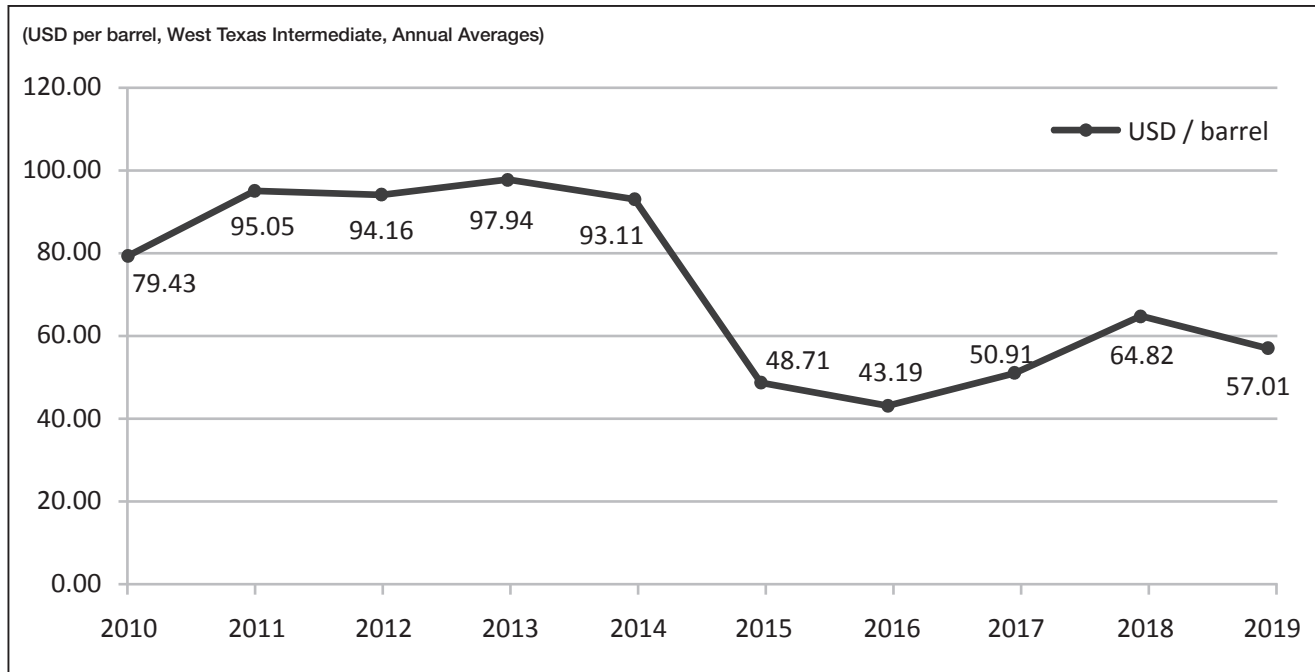

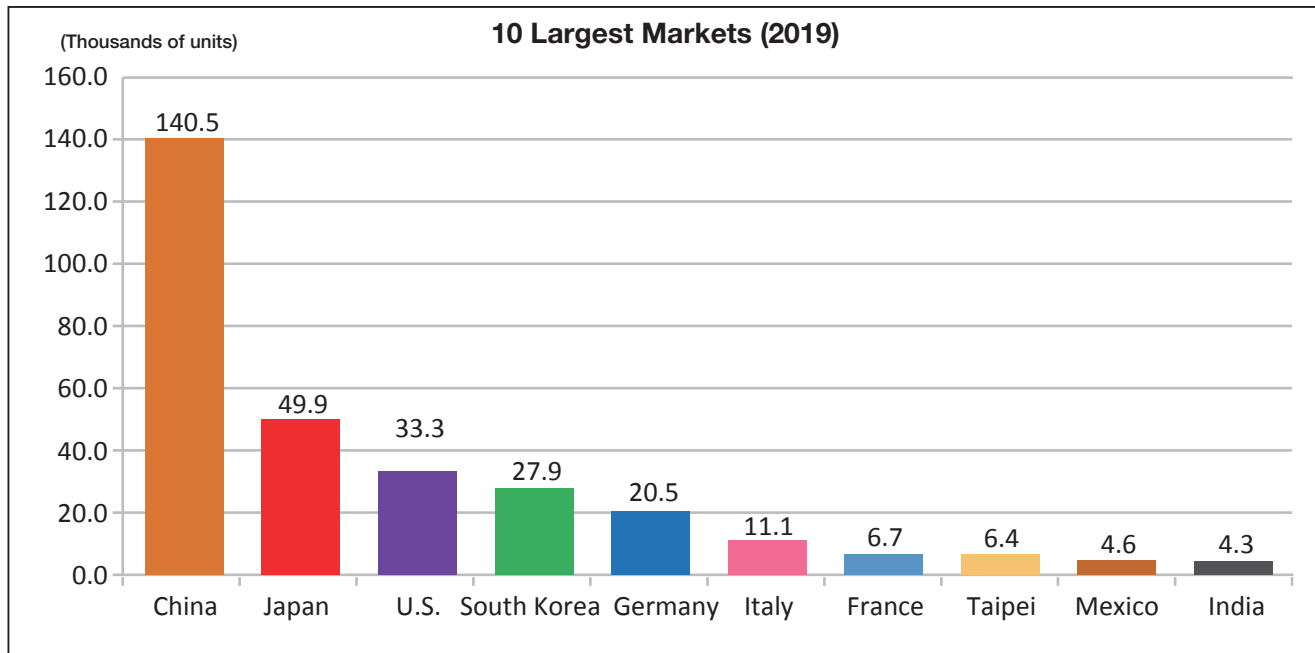

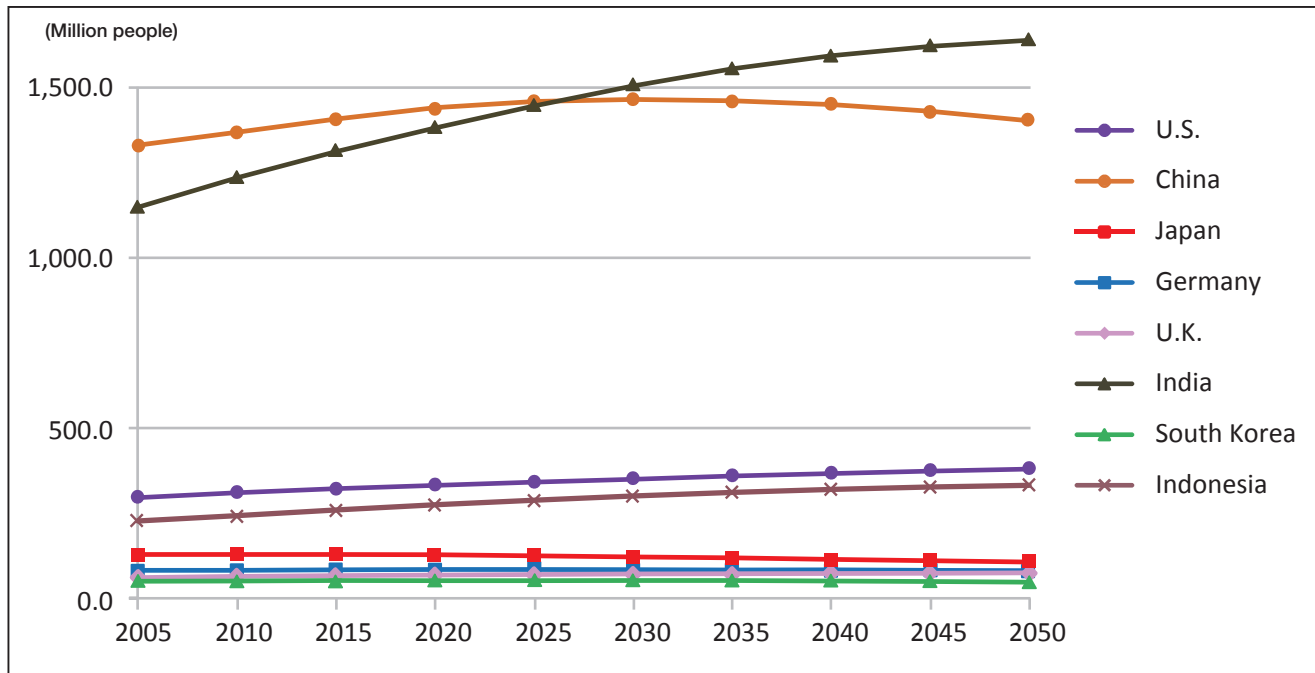

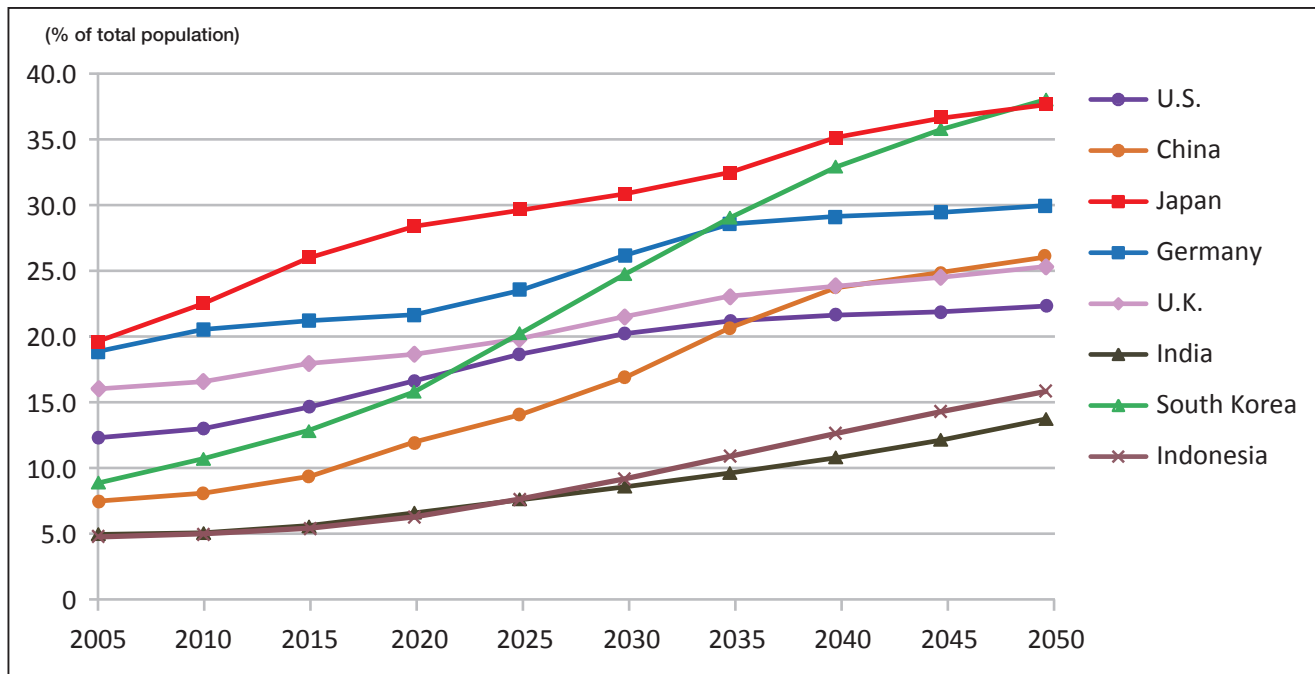

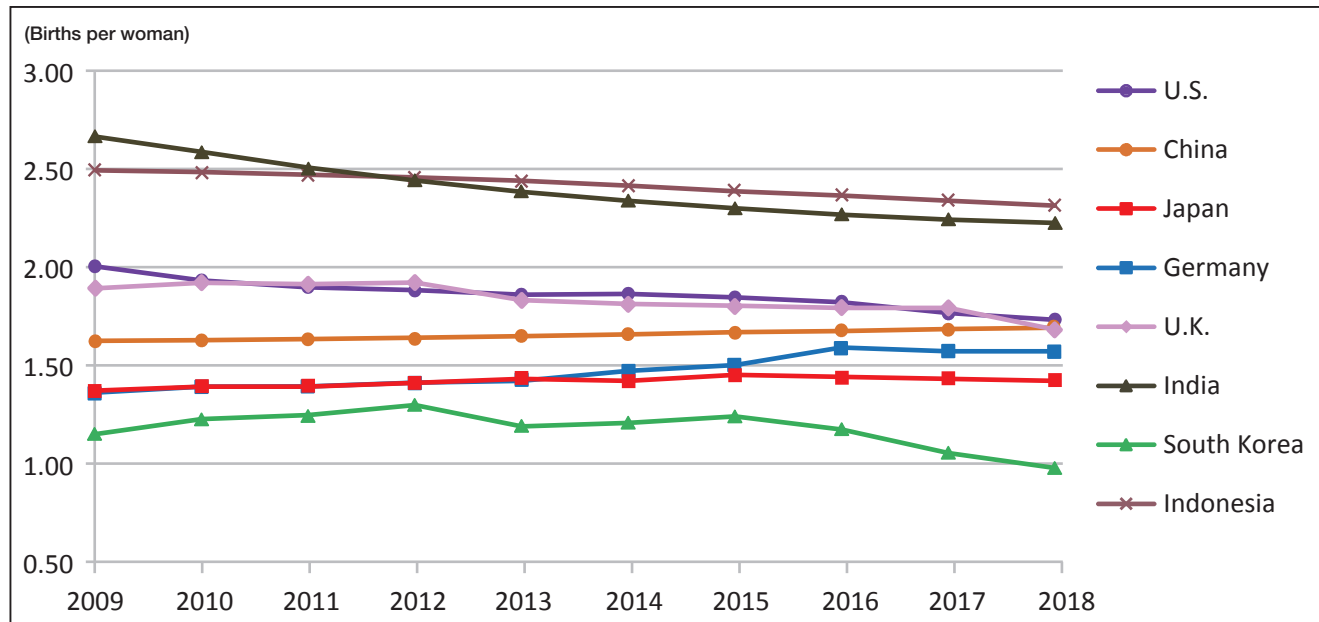

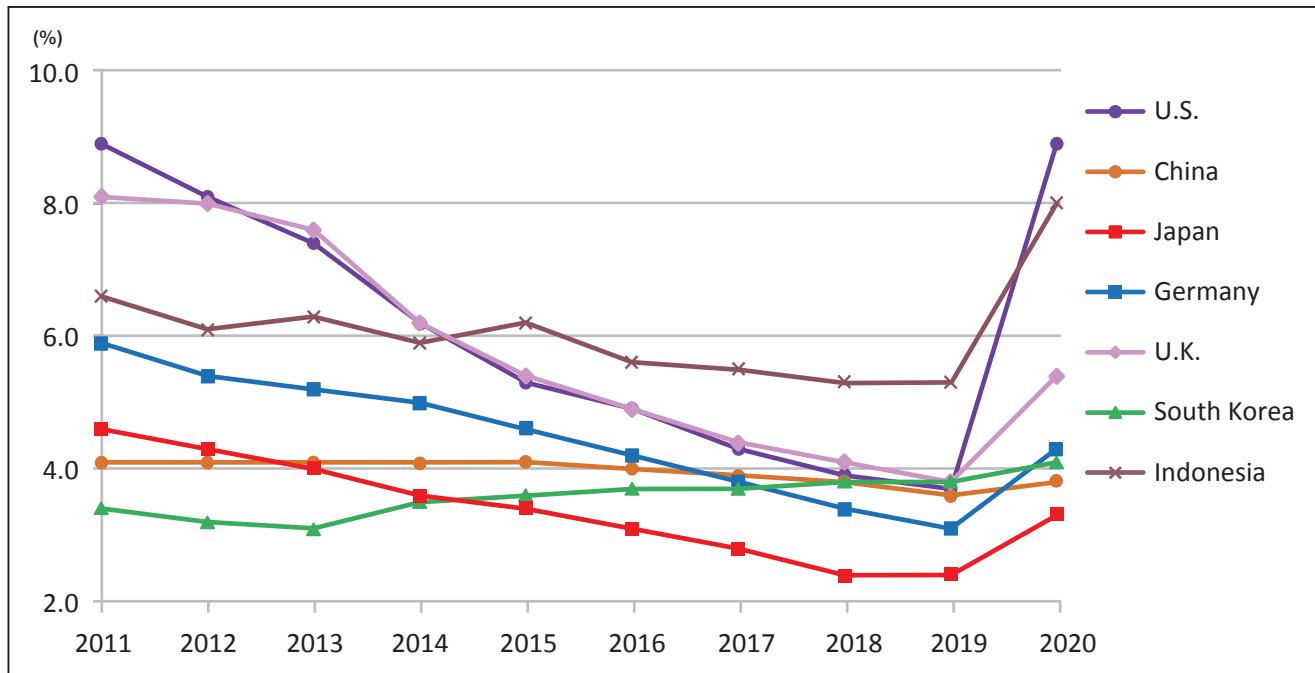

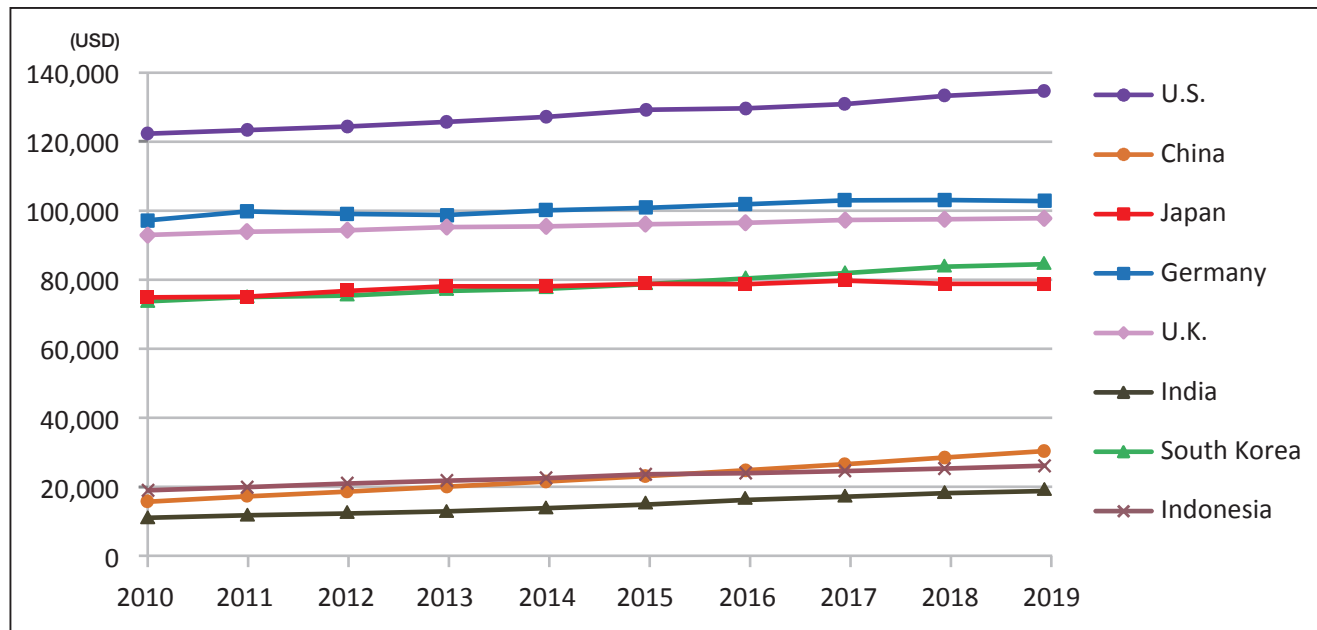

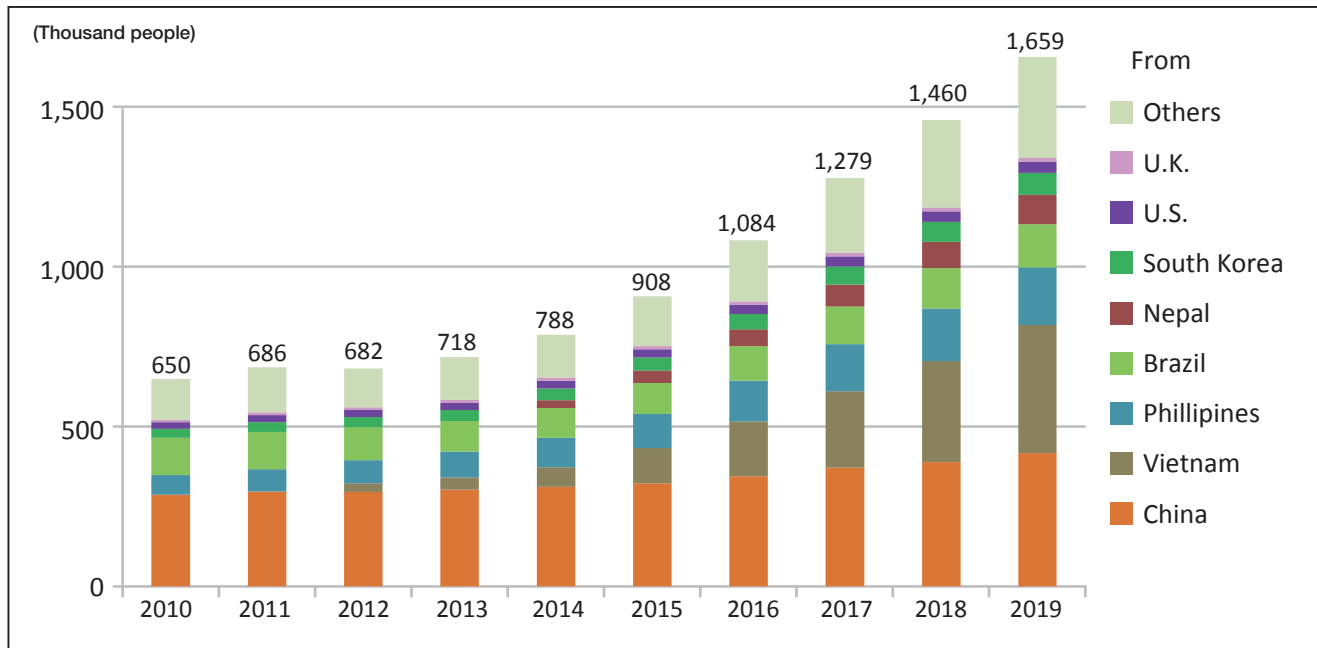

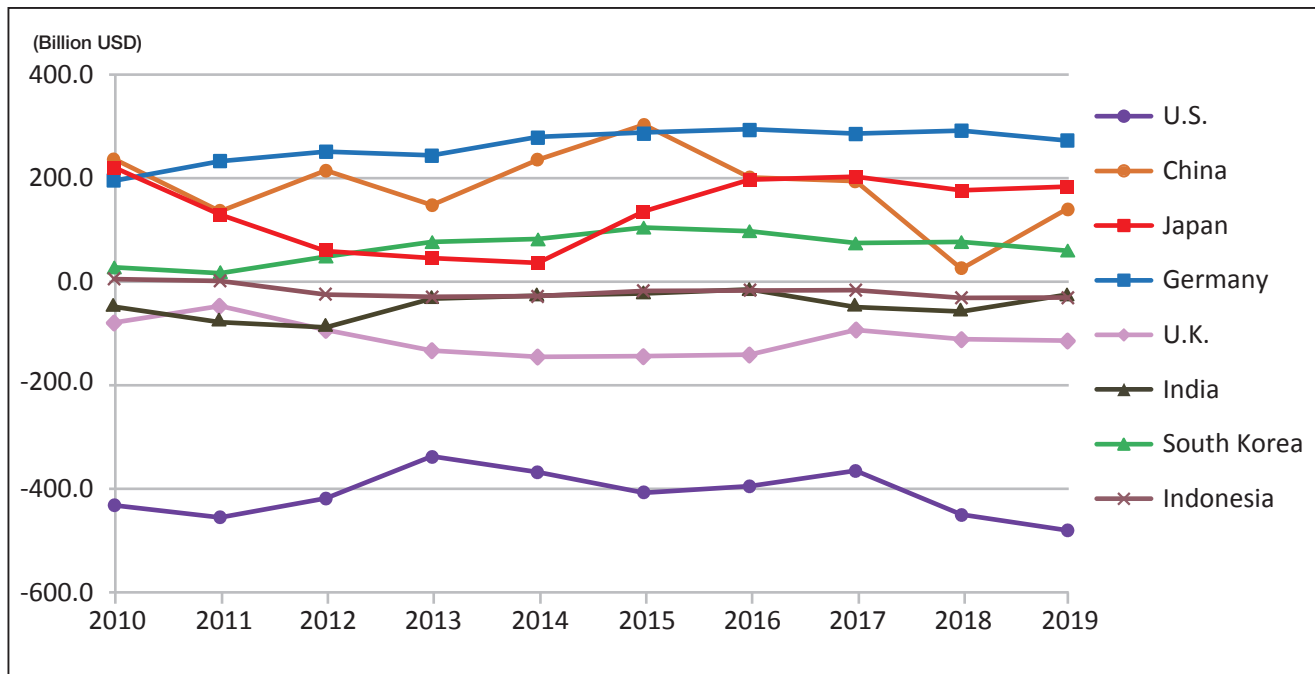

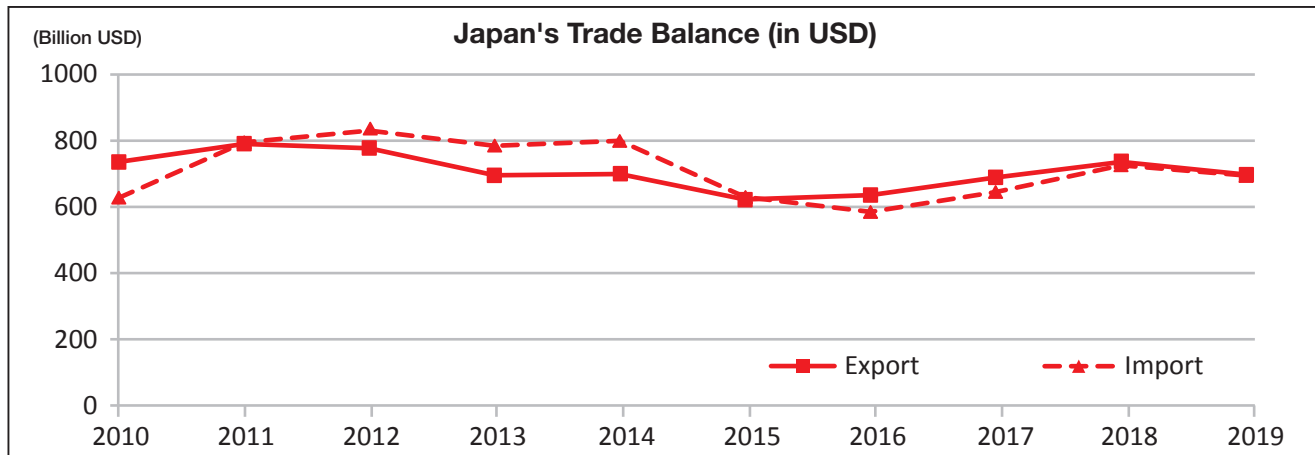

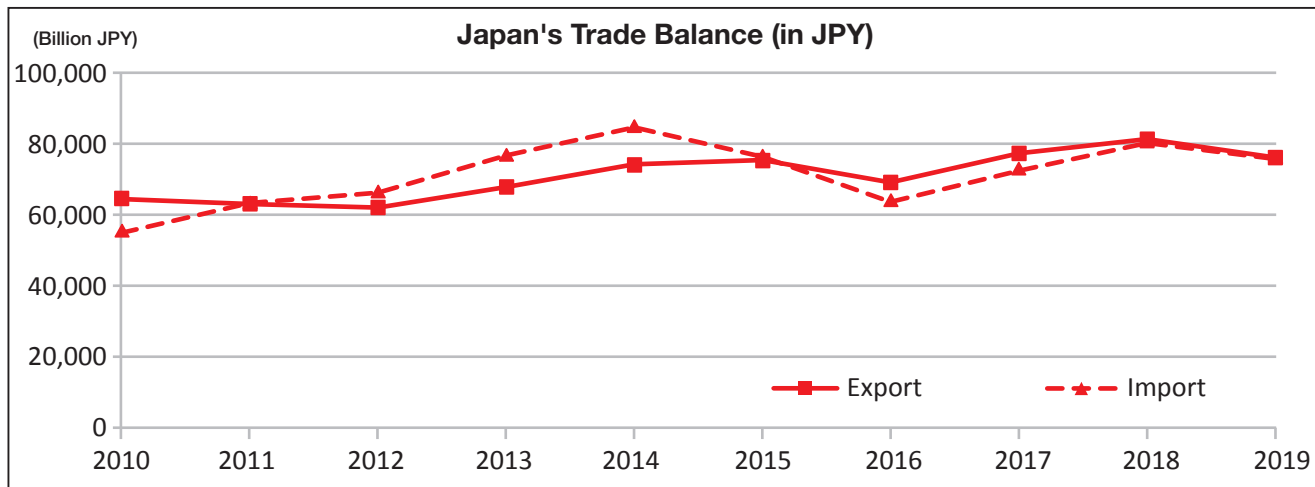

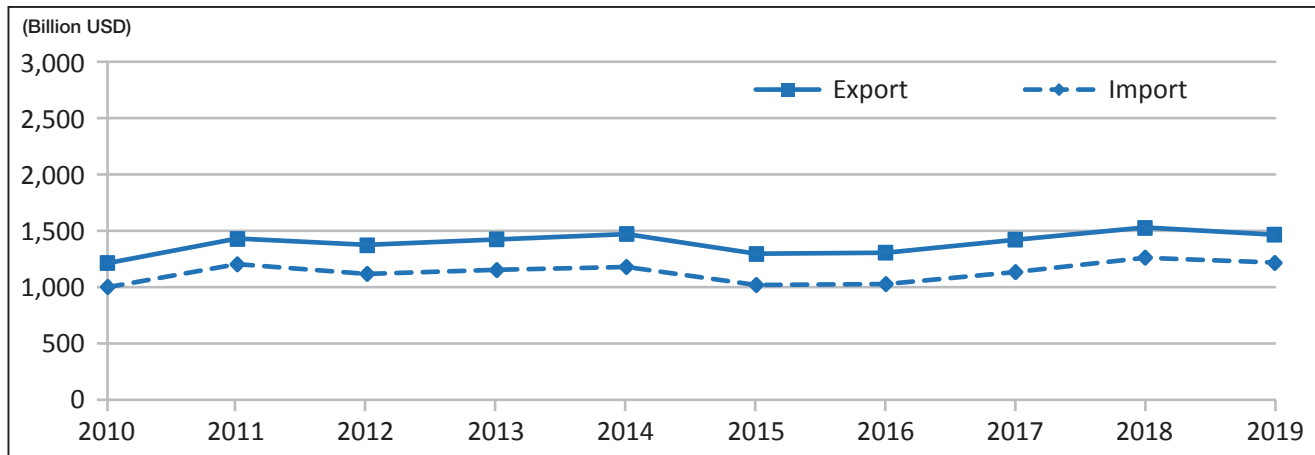

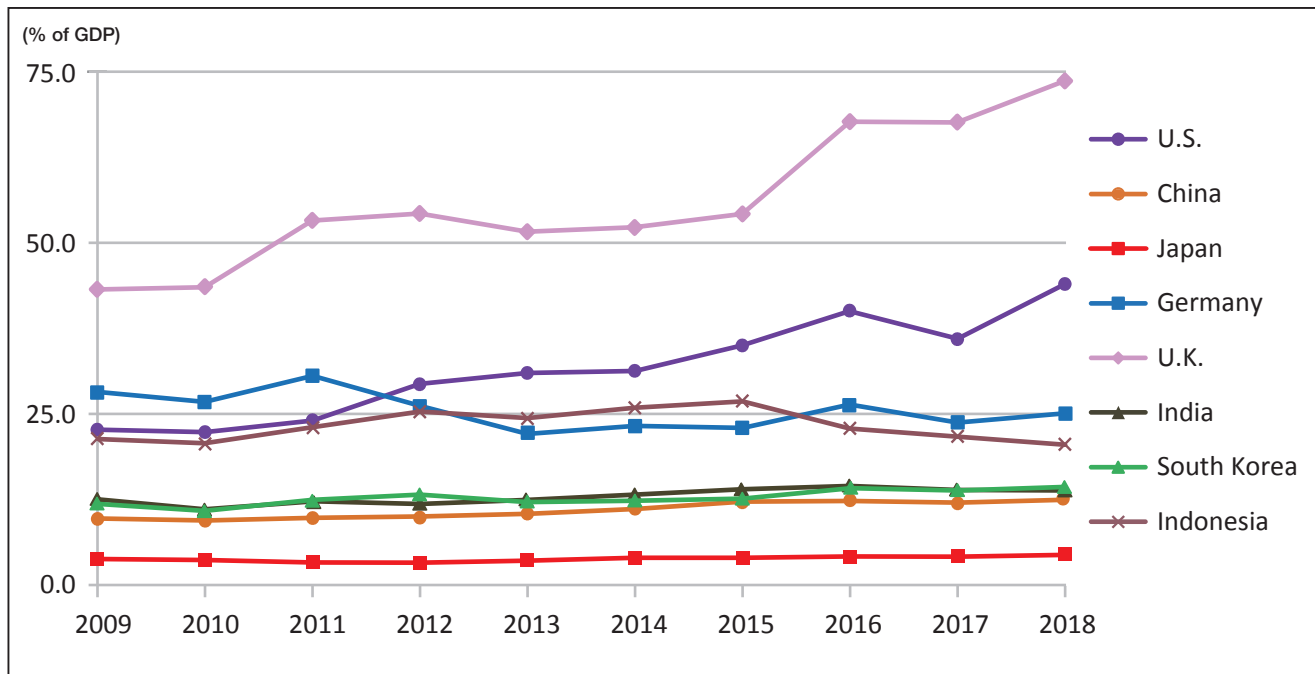

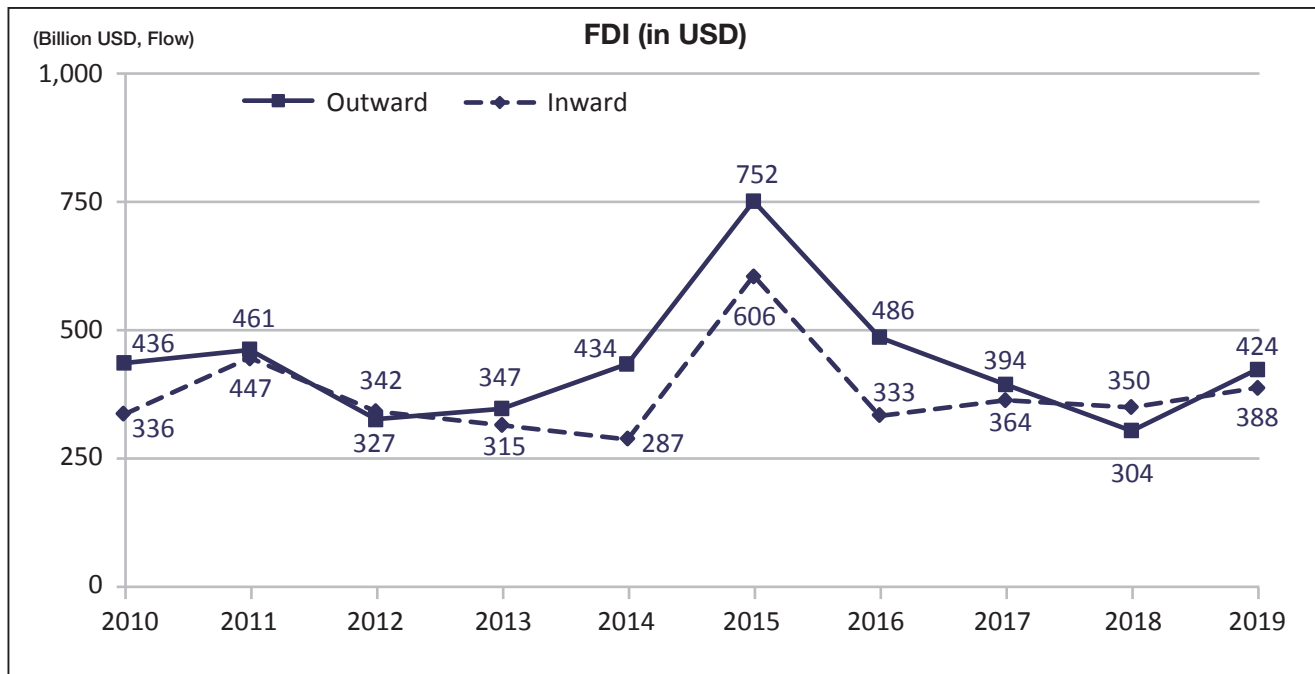

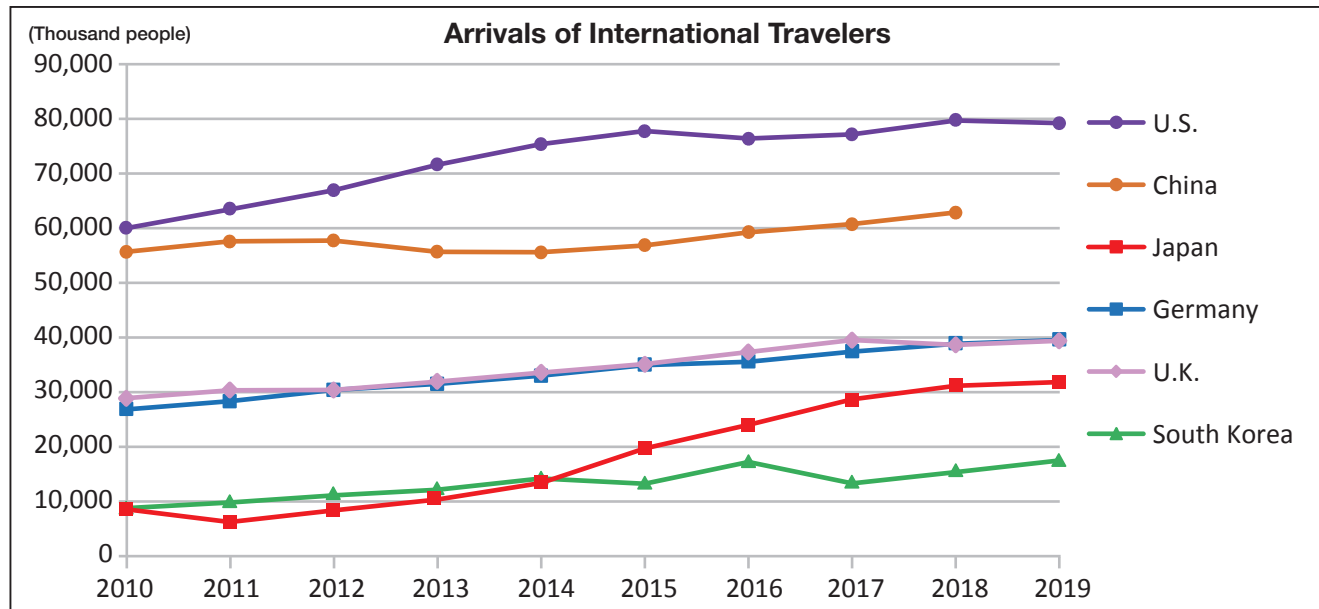

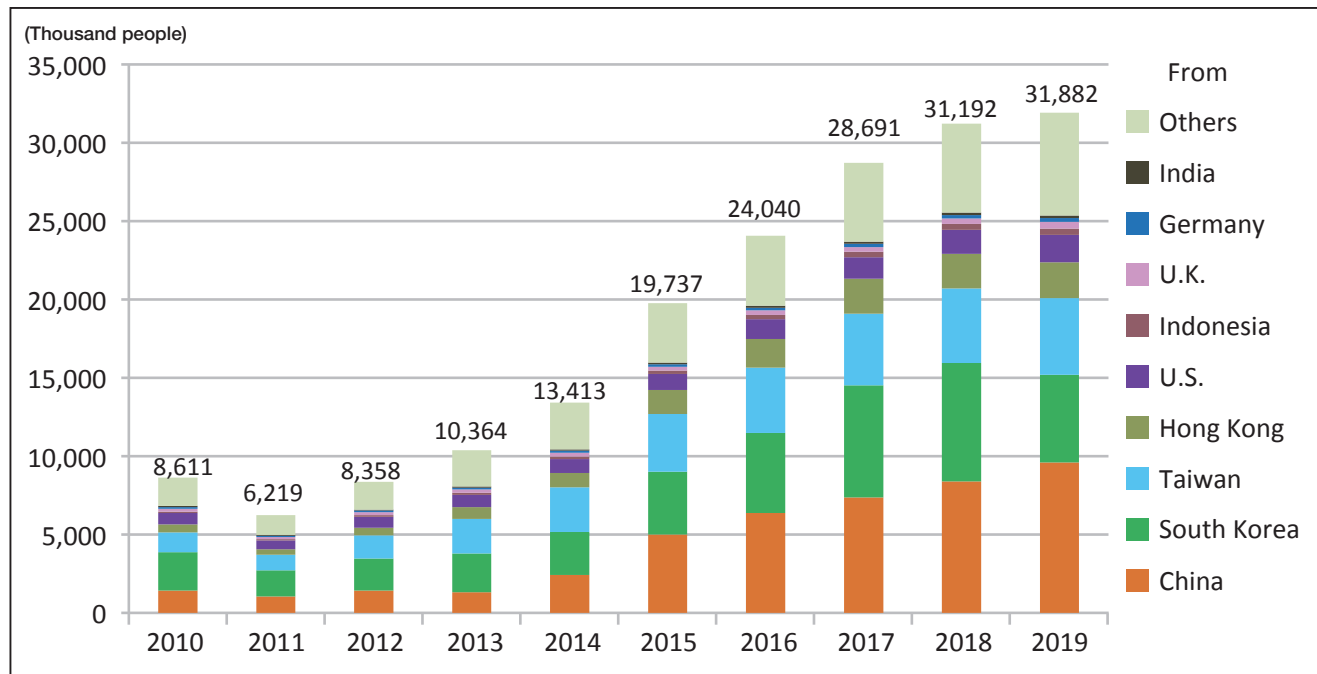

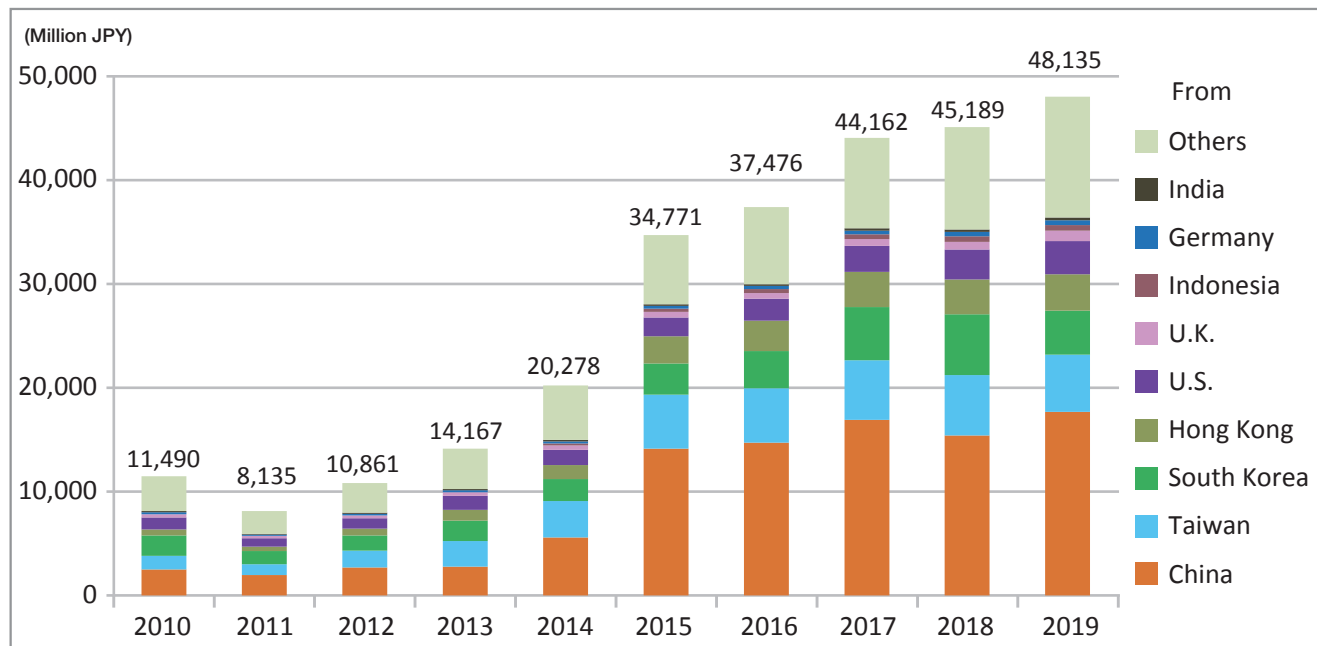

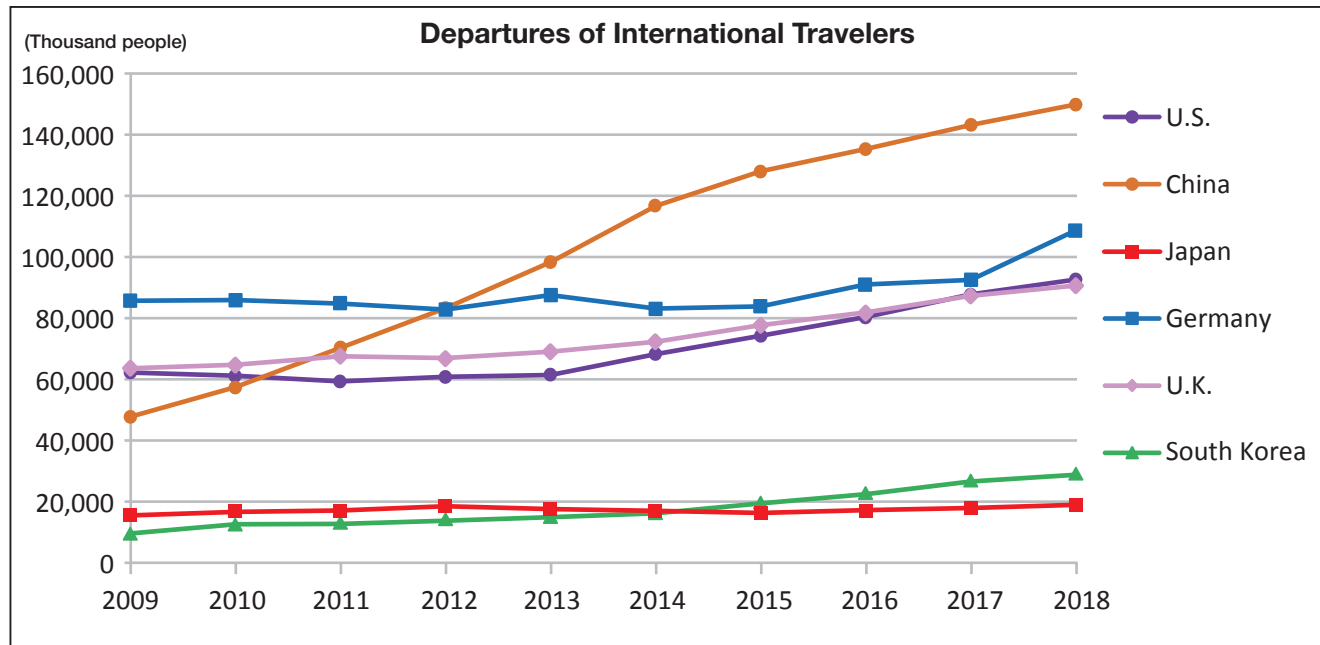

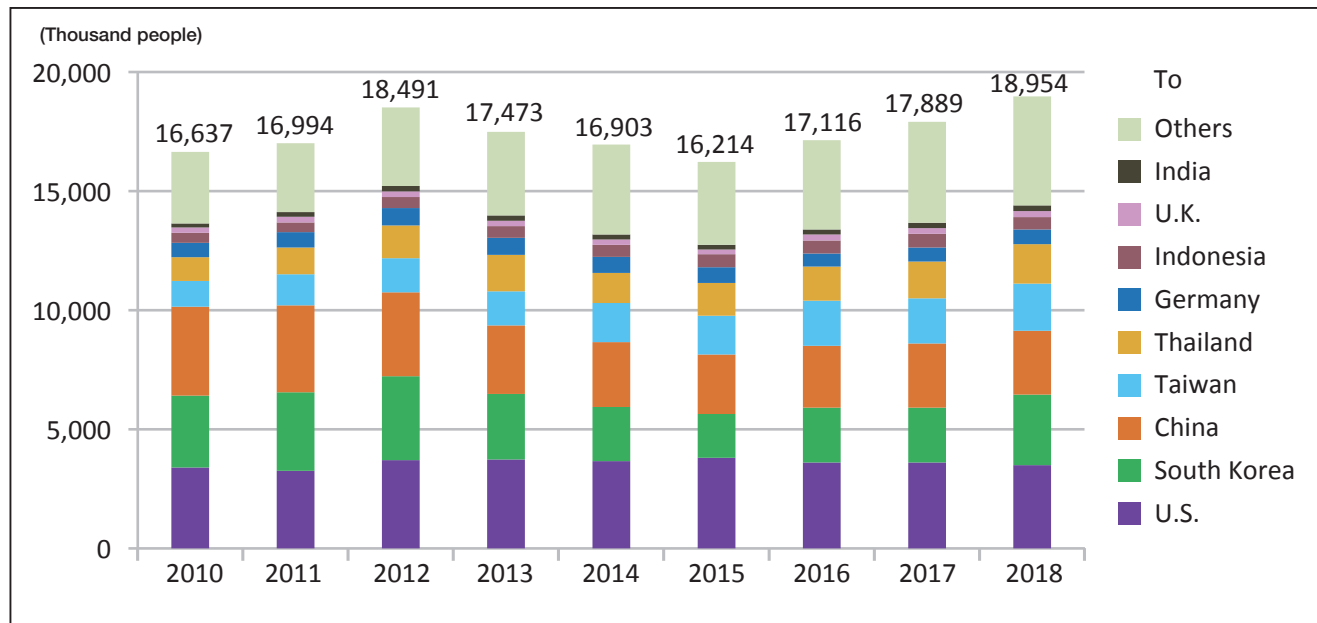

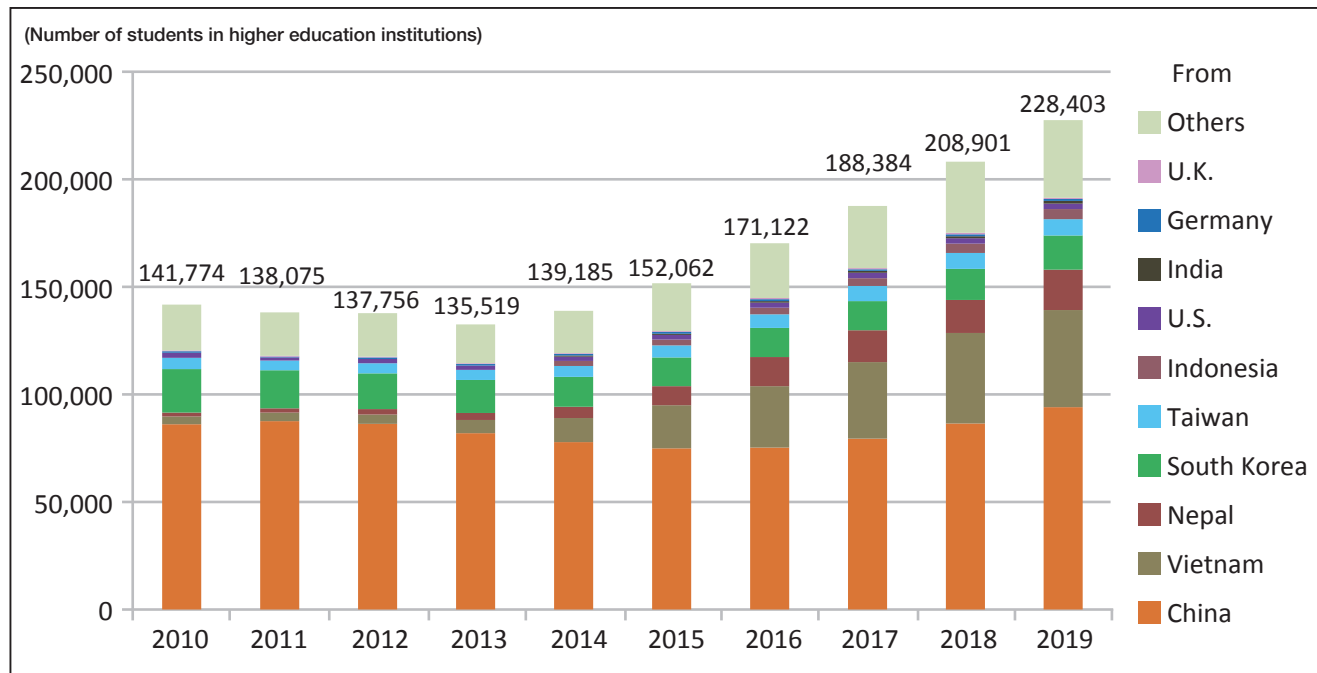

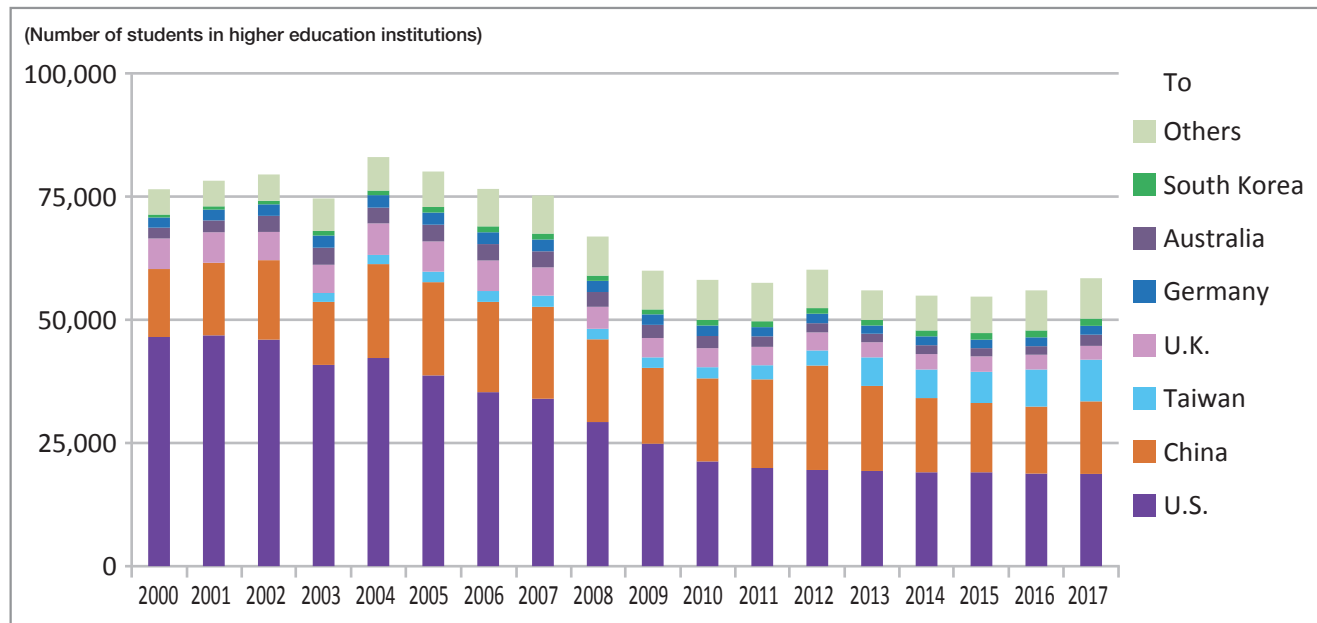

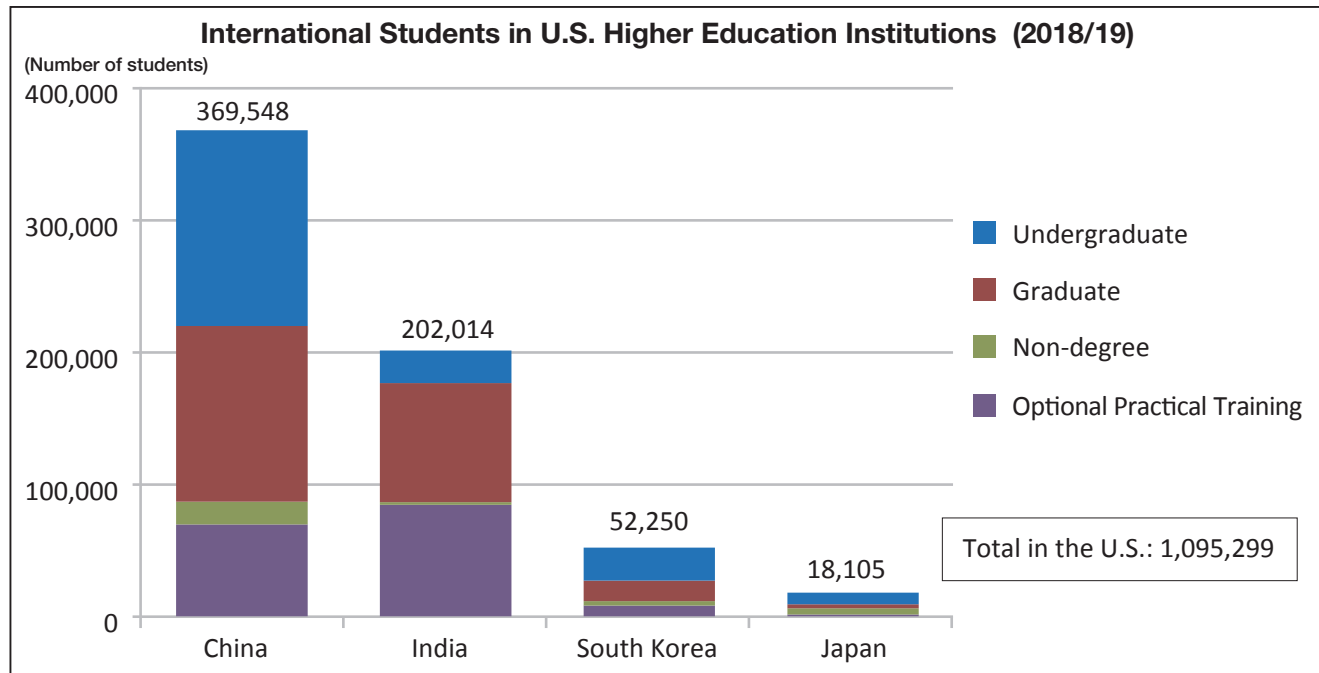

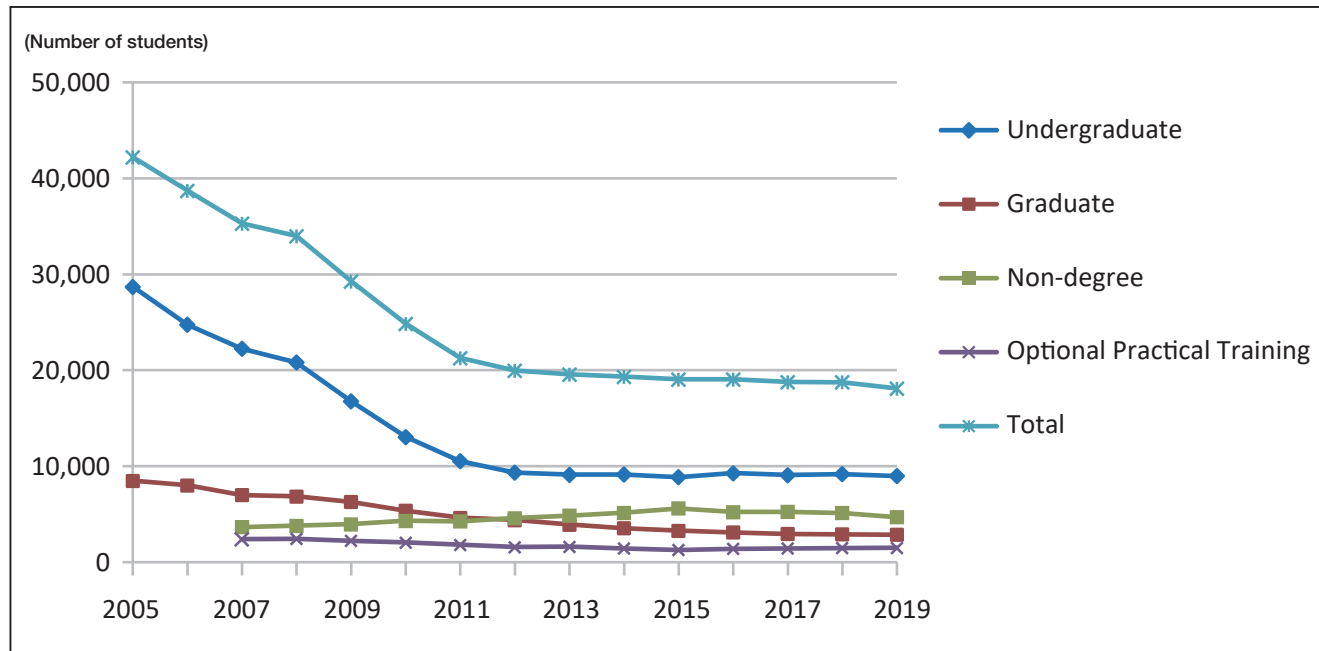

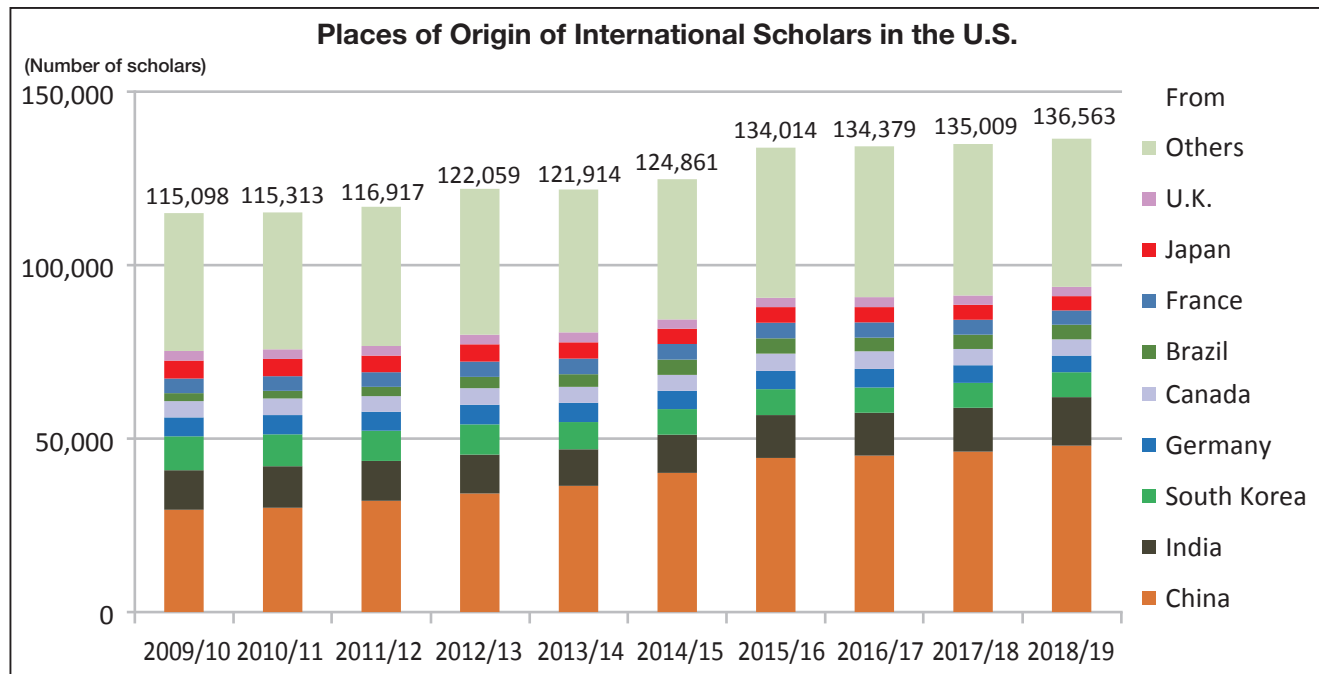

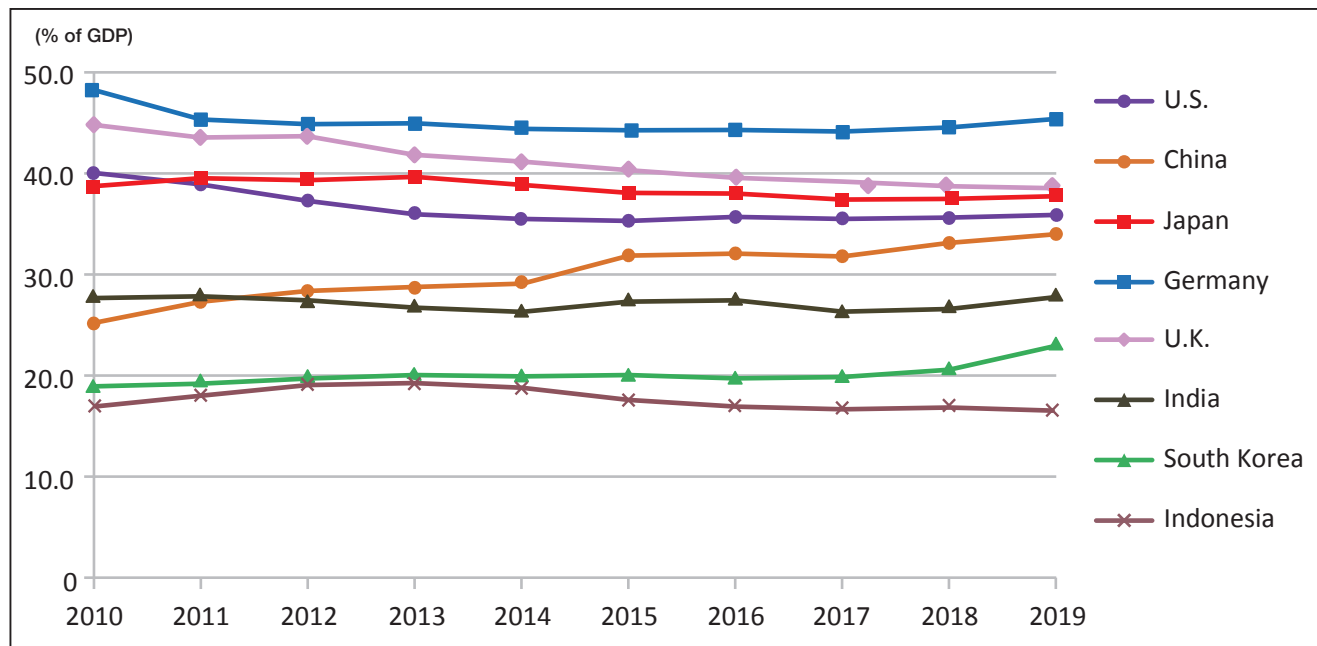

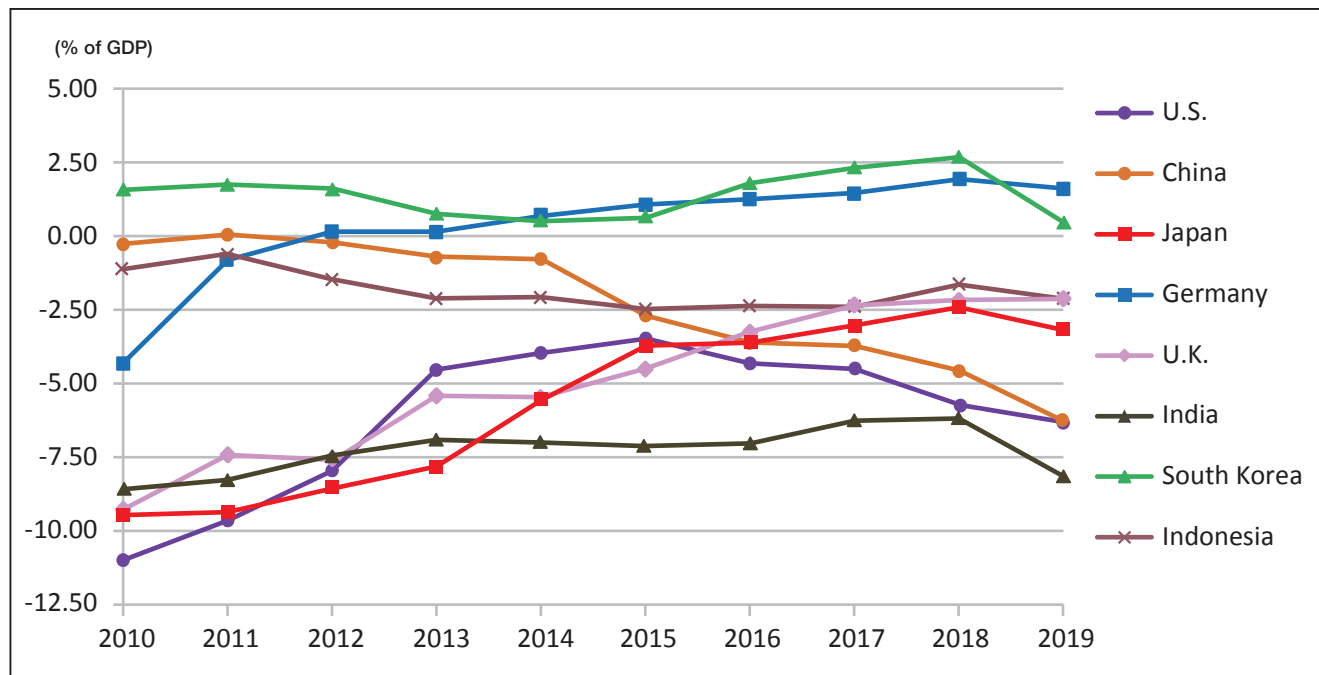

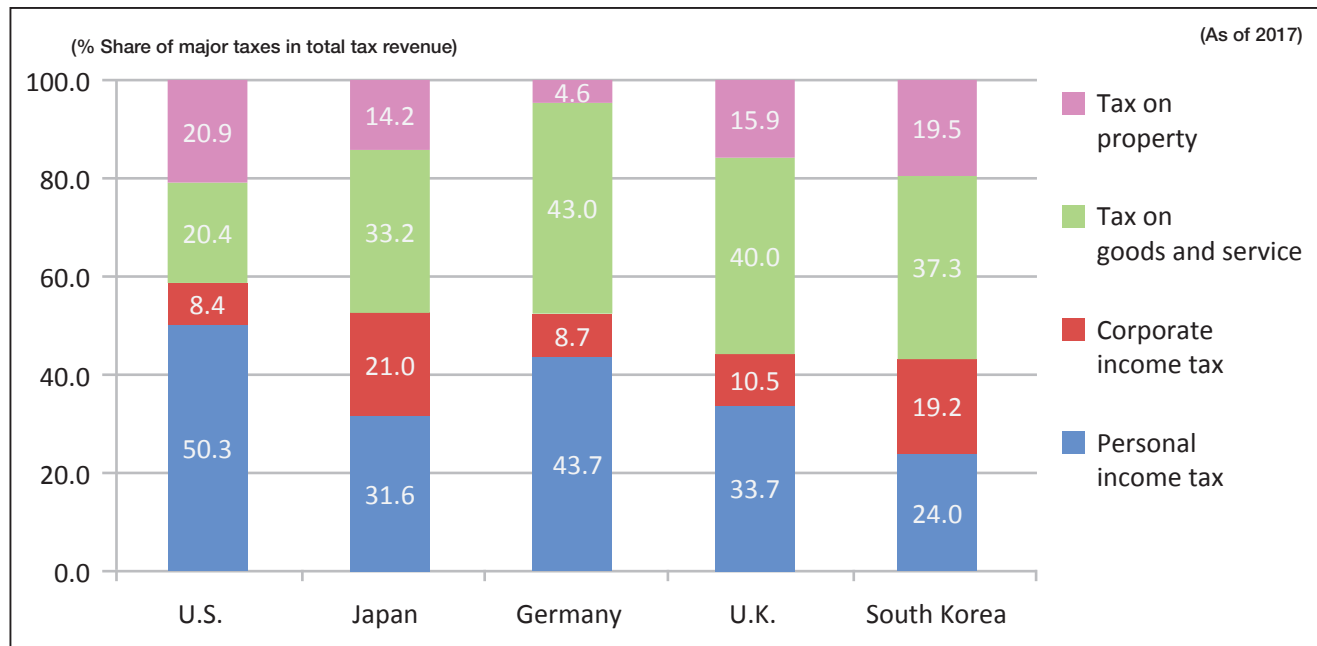

税収構成比

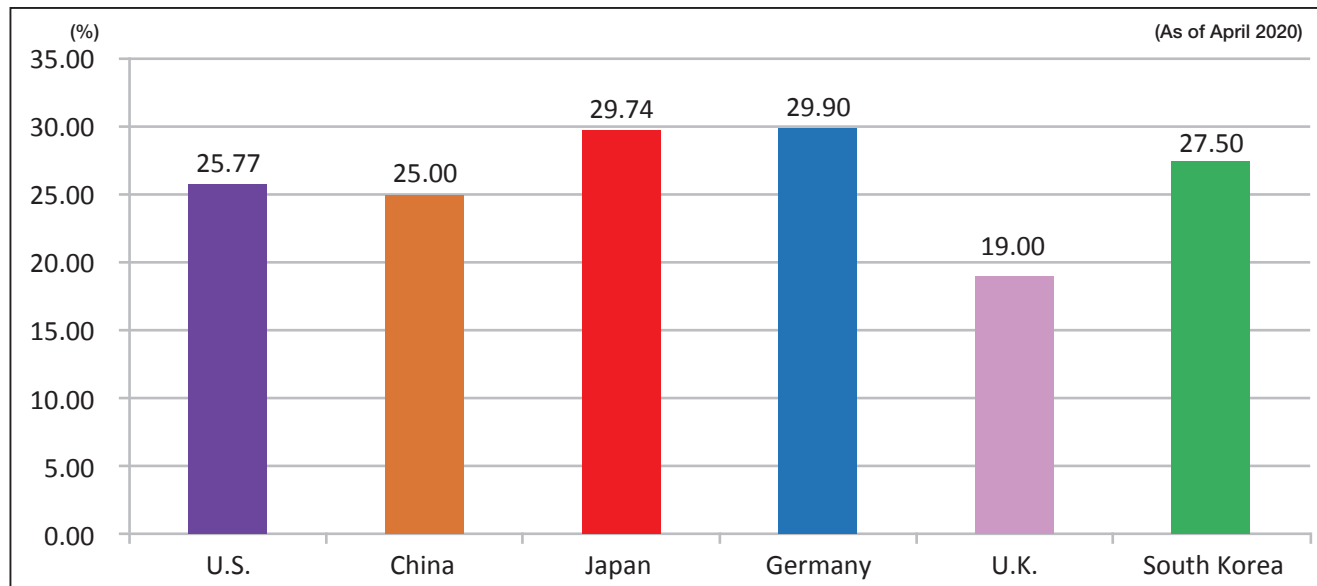

法人実効税率



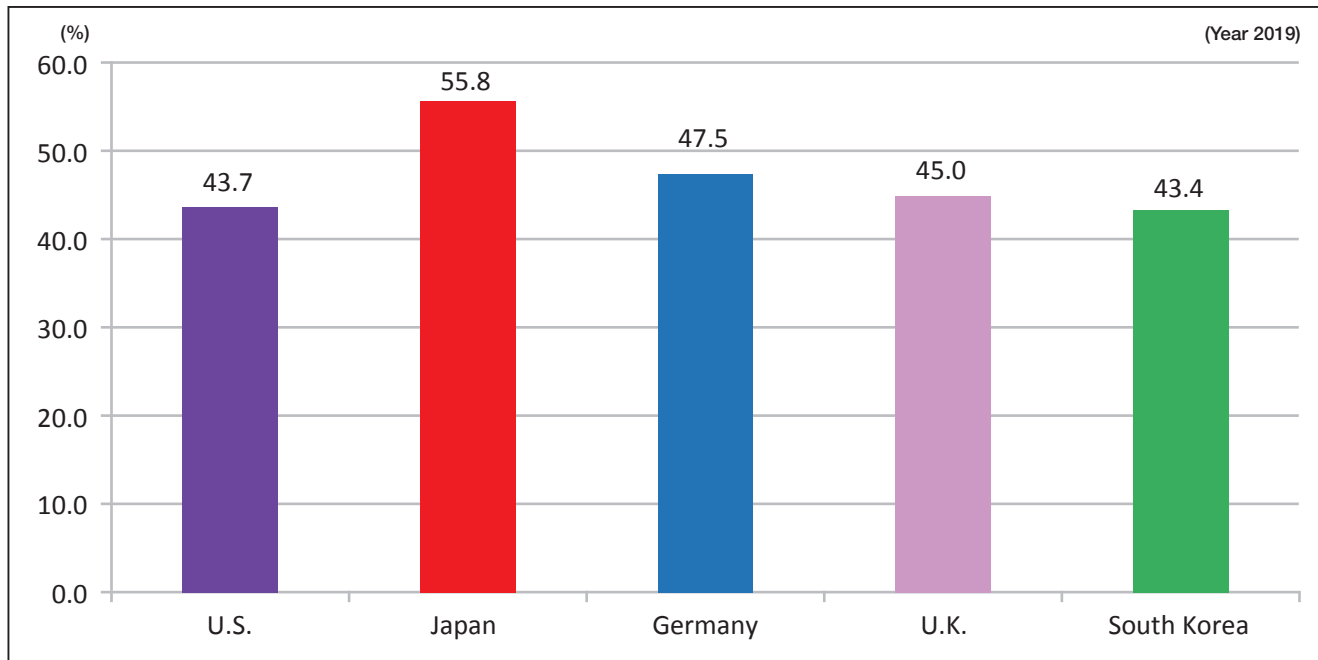

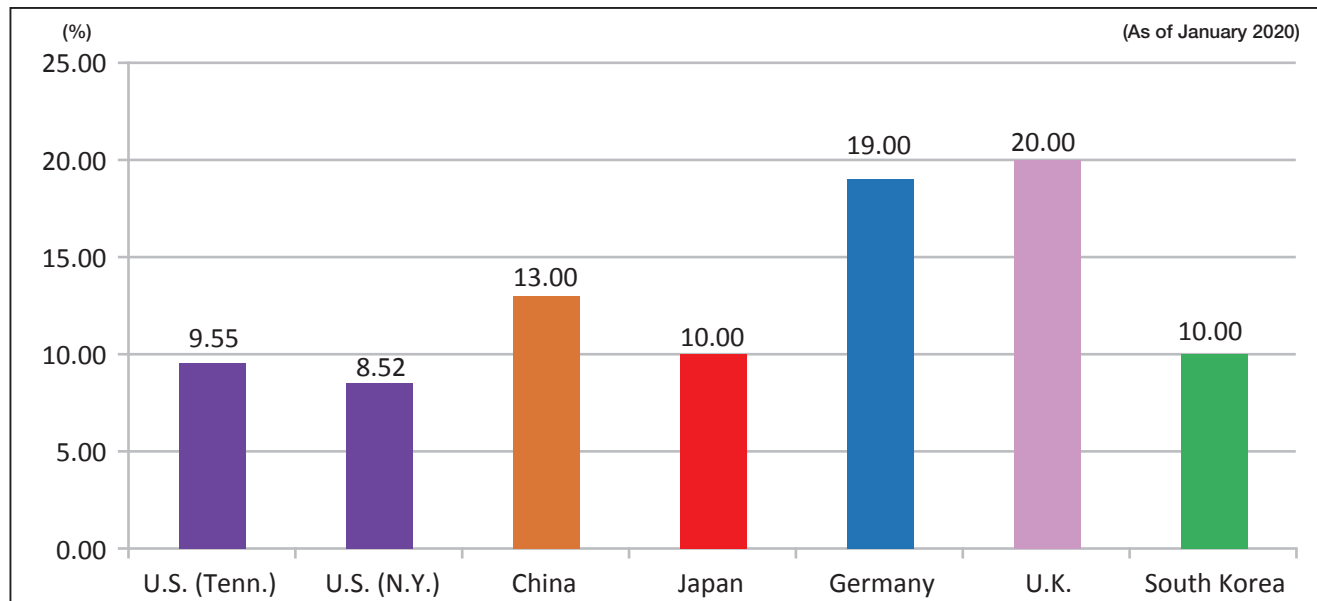
5-5 Top Marginal Personal Income Tax Rates

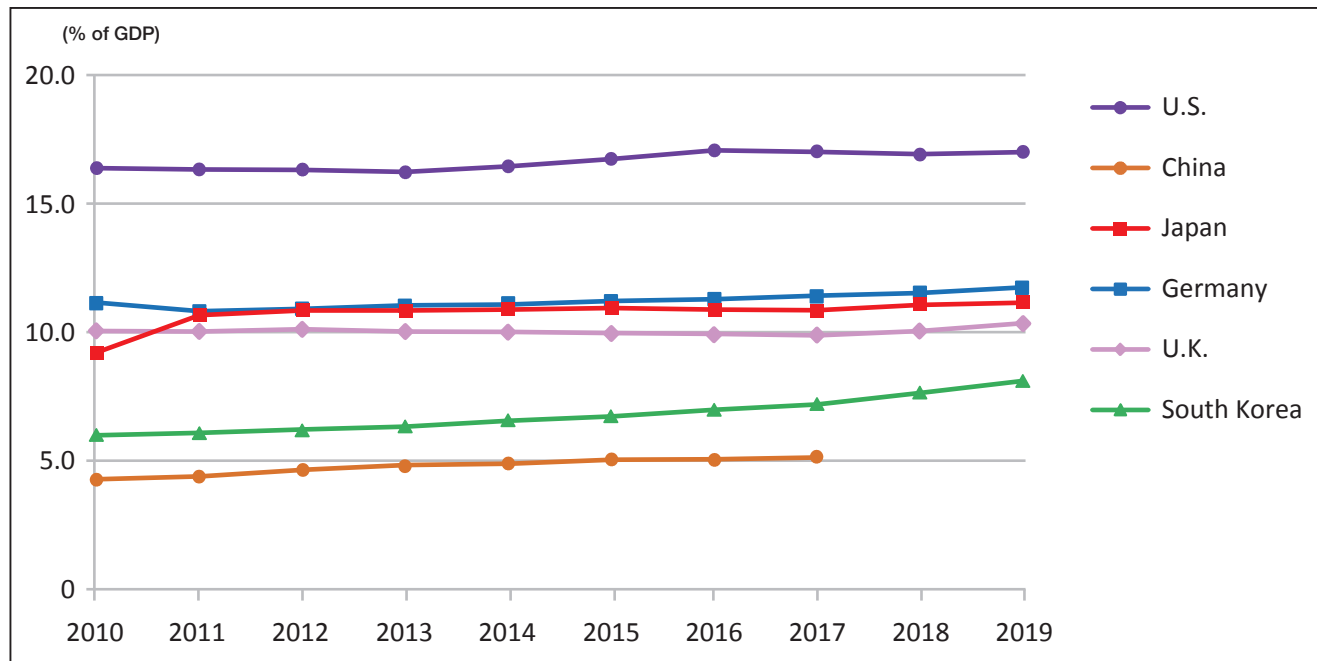

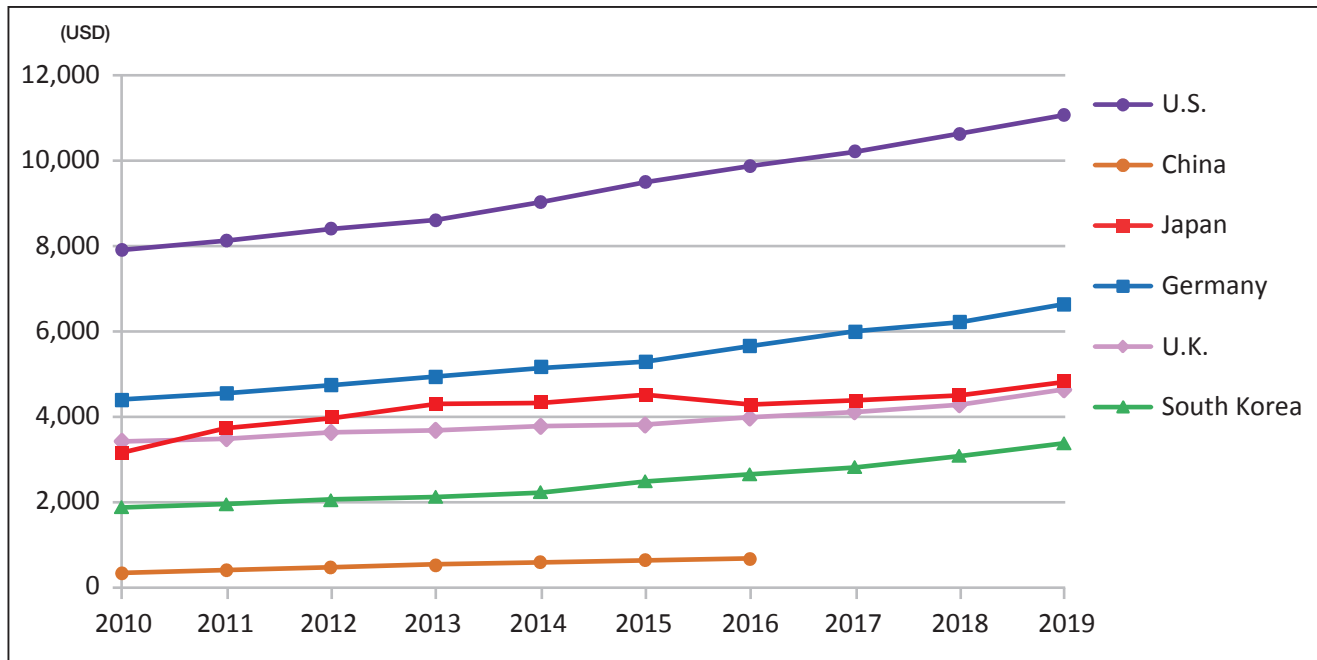

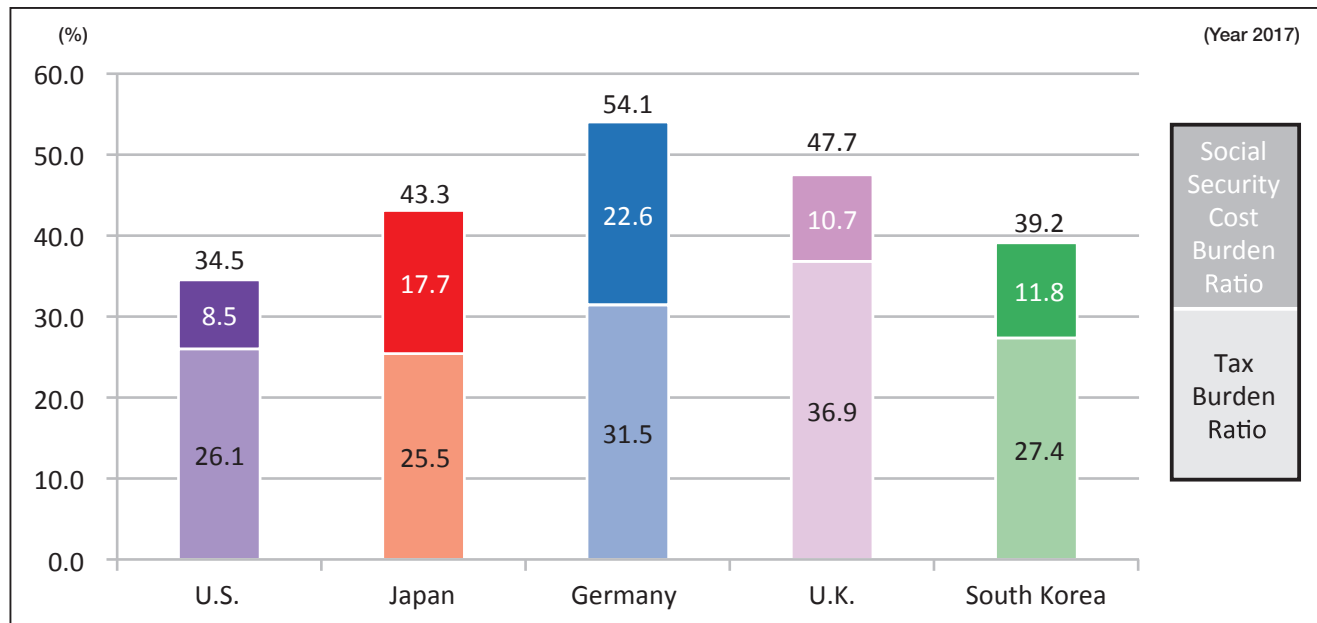

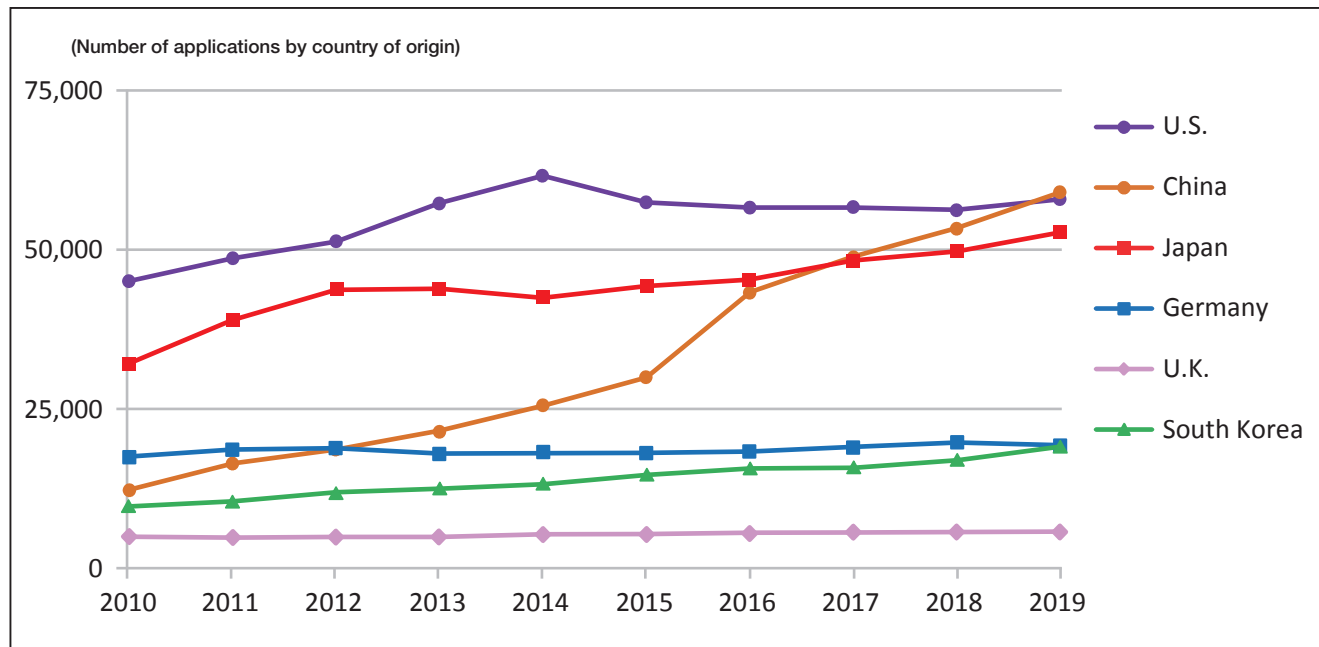

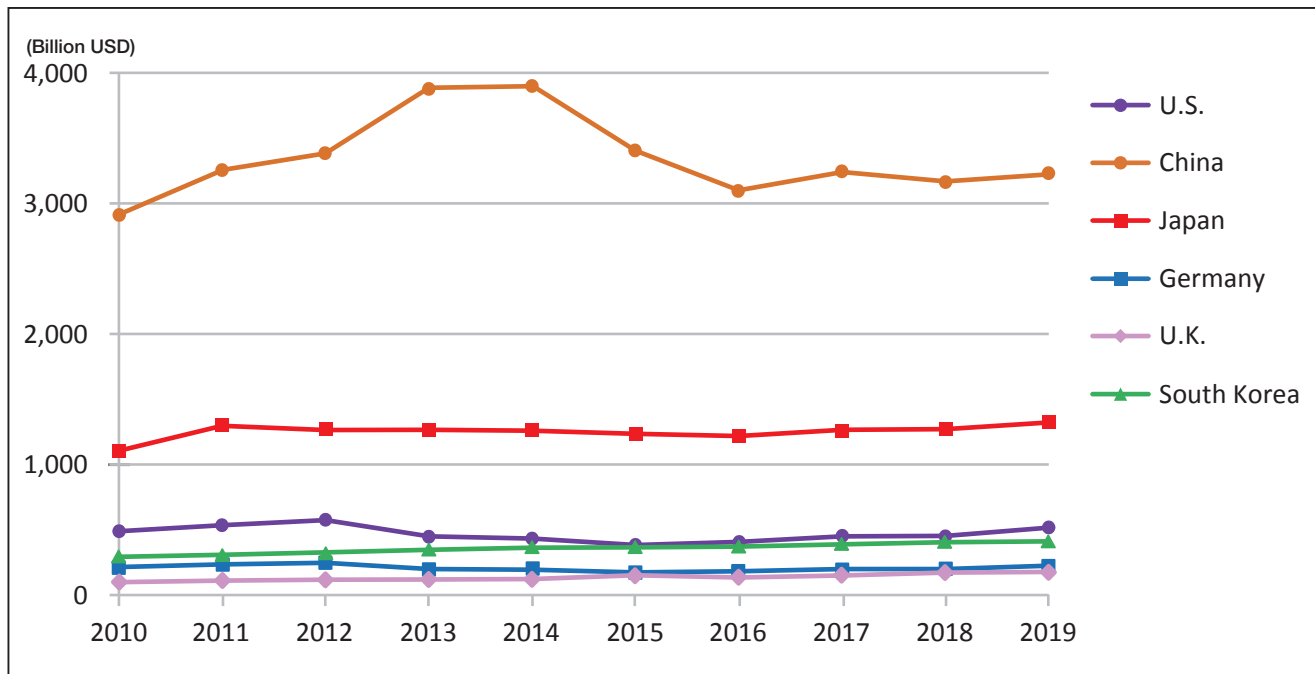

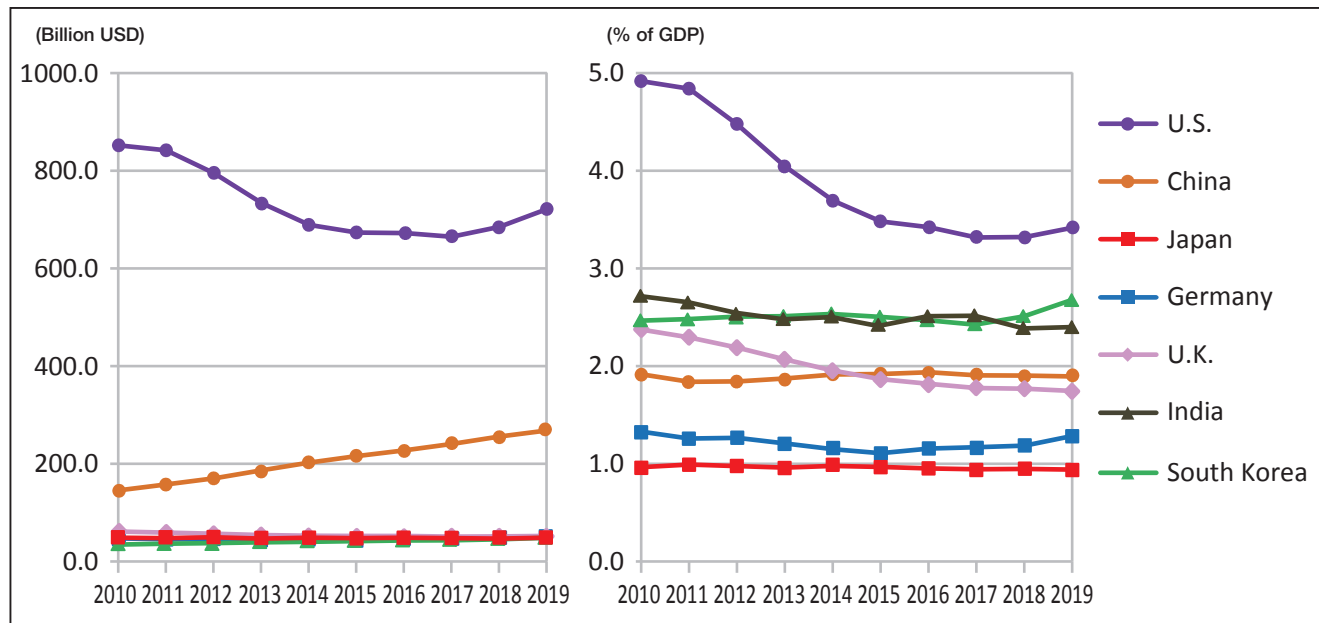

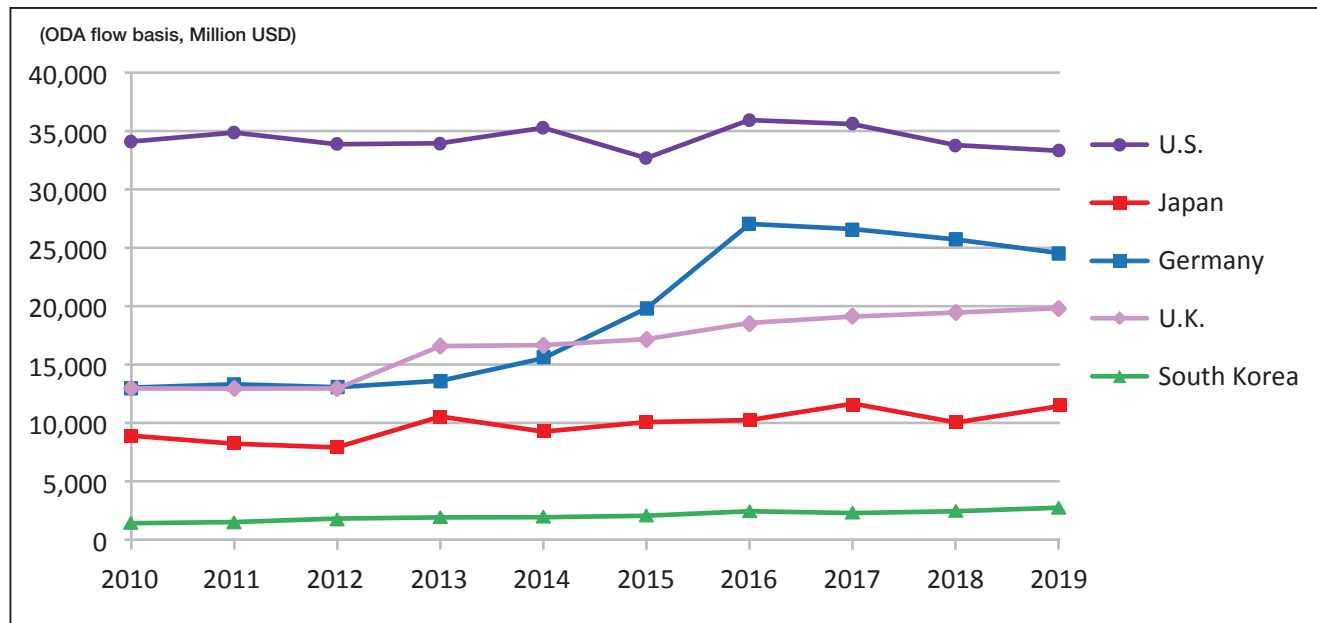

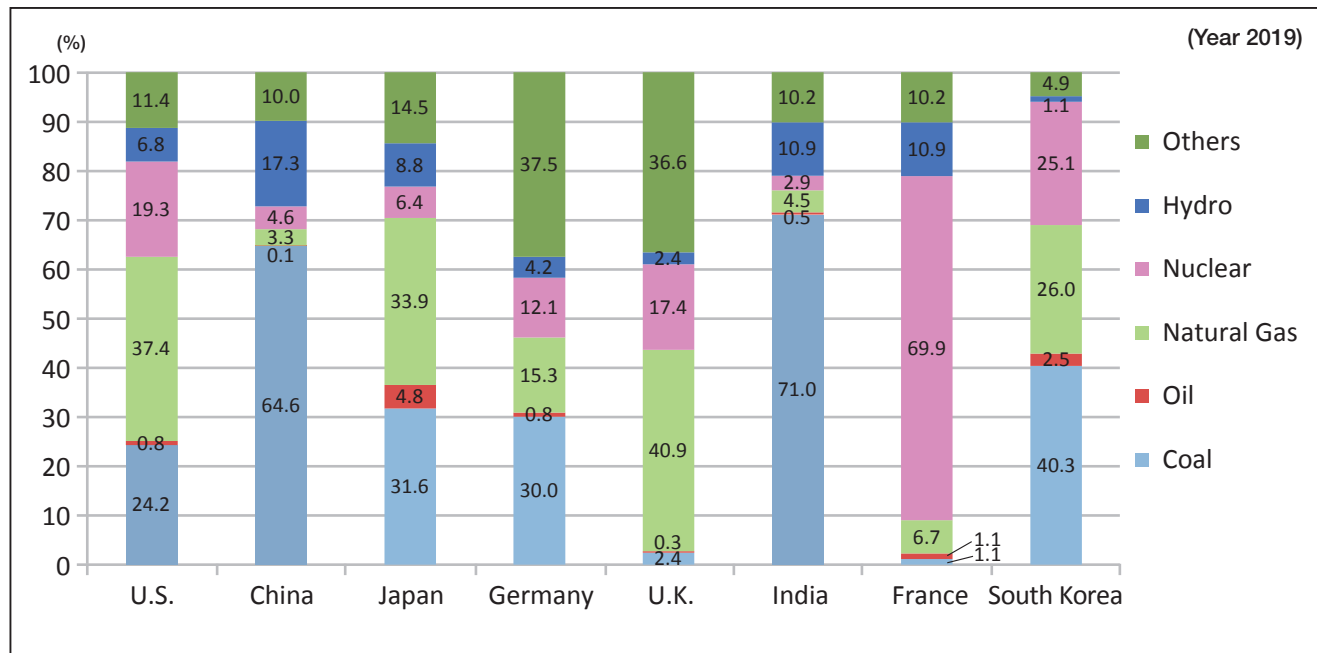

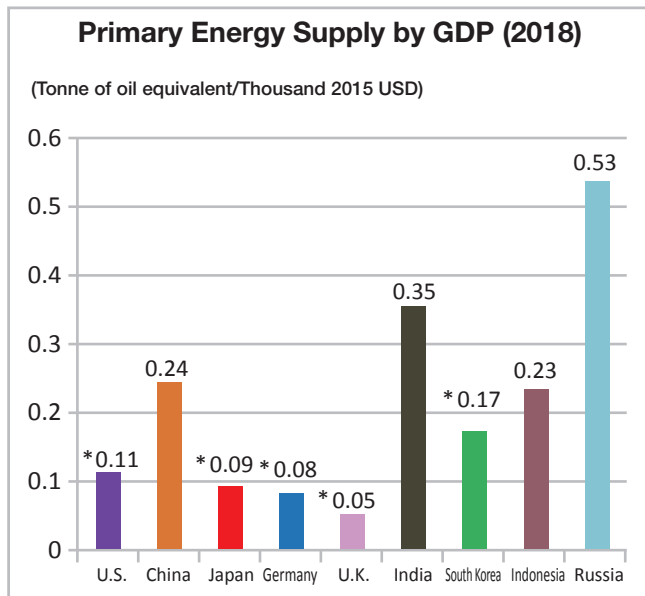
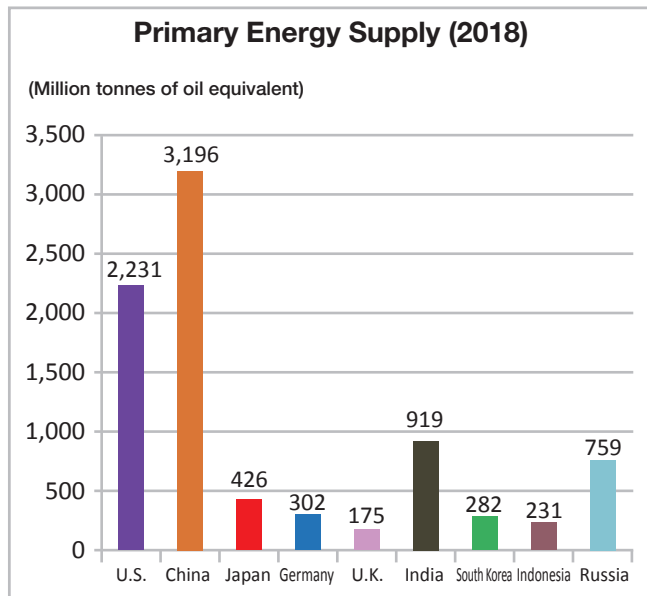
電源別発電電力量の構成比

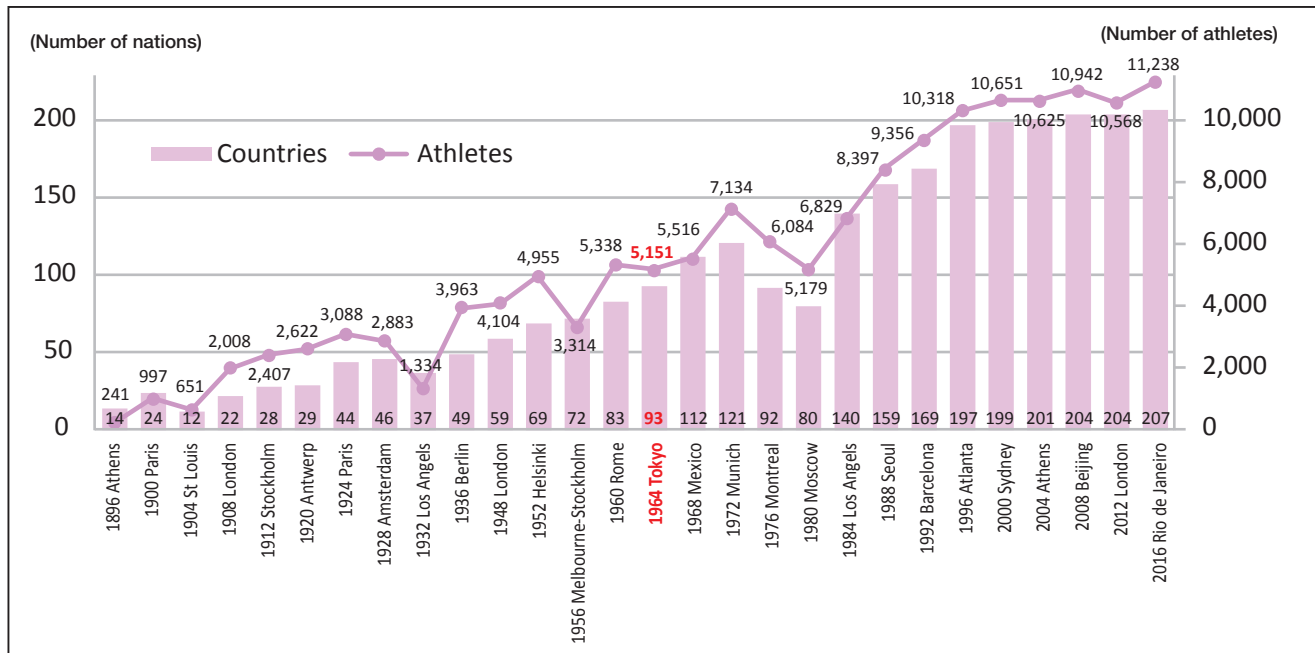

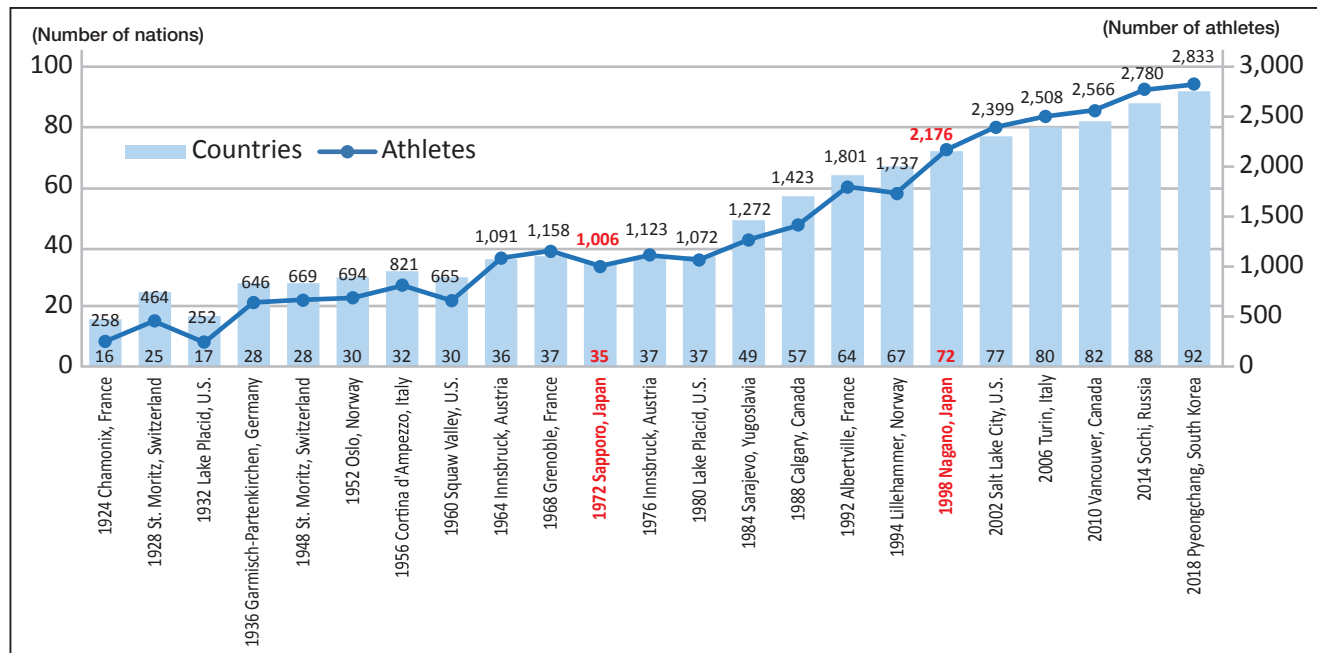
